He was wounded in Iraq/Iran between 1981-1984 on a reconnisance mission. He was shot in the heart which cut one of his heart valves into. He is very lucky to be alive.

Sharon had a baby girl on December 7, 1992. She weighed 6 lbs., 4 oz. and was named Sarah. Mother and daughter are doing fine.

We raised over \$290 in cash donations plus all the food, gifts and clothing that we received for the family. Gail and I shopped for their Christmas dinner (ham, turkey and all the trimmings) and we also bought them blunds, blankets, towels, baby items, children's shoes, etc. Bob Maccia, Steve and I carried their food over a few days before Christmas. Then Martha Mobley, Steve and I took their gifts to them about 10:00 pm on Christmas Eve. Sharon said the Children had been in bed since 6:30 pm because they were so excited about Santa coming and James, the father, had been pacing the floor waiting for us to get there. We stayed about 45 minutes helping them sort gifts and talking. When we were ready to leave, Sharon started to cry and said to tell everyone how much they appreciated the BSC caring about them. She said they only wanted something for the children and were overwhelmed by everything. The BSC officers wuld like to say to everyone who contributed to this very needy family how proud we are of you for caring and it is a privilege to know each and every one of you.




