Shagging's the only dance for beach music

The man held his hand out expectantly, then clamped his thumb over my fingers and nudged my left hand up high on his shoulder.

He was wearing loafers without socks and a lot of cologne.

When the music began, Nathan Worrell frowned at my feet, which weren't doing what they were supposed to do.

"Stop flinging," said Nathan. "You shouldn't fling your arm so much. Hold it like you're holding a drink. Don't move around so much."

Was he kidding?

Don't move to music? Maybe this explains why I've never mastered the shag - the dance of choice among many coastal Carolinians.

Shagging enthusiasts can be as different as The Embers and Hootie & the Blowfish.

You've got your moneyed gin-and tonics-at-the-club shaggers whose sons tend to be mannersome frat boys who can't imagine not registering Republican and going into the family business and whose daughters wear deep tans and madras skorts and drive daddy's-girl convertibles.

And you've got your regular workingclass folk - including a disproportionate number of car salesmen whose very DNA seems code to tap a sockless, loafered foot to *Myrtle Beach Days* or sing along to *Under the Boardwalk*, always saying, "Boardwalk! Boardwalk" real loud at the end.

When it's done right, shag is fascinating to watch, more rigidly choreographed than the bia *Miss America* dance routine, the one all 50 women get to do, even though 40 of them know they haven't placed and gamely dance on.

If you watch shag long enough, there's something in Southern blood that makes you want to join in. It's the

only way to dance to beach music, that bouncy horn-based stuff that celebrates the beer-drinking, lovemaking aspects of simple-minded Southerners.

"Nother words, this ain't brain surgery, but it's fun".

Shag looks like a fancified jitterbug with a basic cha-cha step. After you've learned the basic step, you add turns and kicks and learn how to respond appropriately when your partner whispers "boogie walk" or "pro-start" or Tom 'n Connie" in your ear

"Five-six-seven-eight..."

On "eight", the women in beginning shag class inch right feet up, then left, then repeat, then rock backward, then forward.

Elizabeth Currie Meadows, instructor at the Sunday afternoon shag class at Wrightsville Beach Park, is a wisp of a woman with painted-on jeans and a steady smile.

"Dancin's supposed to be fun!" she reminds us while we stare at our feet. "You see some people doing the shag and it looks like work. Smile!"

Elizabeth has taught hundreds of people how to shag using patience, humor and a tote bag full of tapes with songs like *Whoopin' Thighs and Shama Lama Ding Dong*.

She's seen fights break out on the dance floor when one shagging partner takes issue with another's style.

"No kind of dancing is worth arguing over", she reminds us with Dolly Parton homespun wisdom.

Paulette Duncan, who has been chiding her husband, Lum, for failing to practice all week, looks sheepish.

The Duncans are taking lessons because their son's getting married August 12 and they want to be able to dance at the reception.

"The other in-laws are taking lessons, too". Paulette confided.

Women outnumber men, so we rotate in and out like a coed volleyball game.

"Gentlemen, I want you to practice leading the ladies", says Elizabeth. "Don't throw 'em across the room! And don't lunge!"

After class, Nathan explains he's only been shagging since last October.

"Since I've started shagging, I've lost 50 pounds", he says. "Shagging has changed my life."

The intermediate class follows, with at least 10 men, wearing khaki pants or shorts, no socks, loafers and, here and there, beepers. Women wear shorts and gold belts and shoes. Their gold purses rest on a counter.

Loafers hiss across the battered linoleum tiles, and Elizabeth offers encouragement to the men, who form a confused hairy-legged chorus line.

A few of these men probably own companies, run corporations, make lots of money, but they're completely befuddled by the tricky Tom 'n Connie move.

"Don't worry", says Elizabeth. "Ya will get it."

"Five-six-seven-eight..."

July Meeting Highlights


