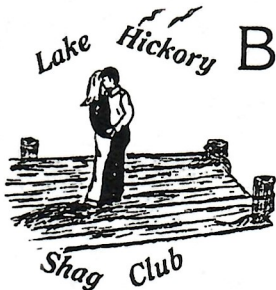
SEASON'S GREETINGS
