Chocolate Eclair Pie Evelyn Turner 1 large and 1 small box vanilla instant pudding mix 4 cups milk (1 quart) 8 ounces Cool Whip Graham Crackers 1 can chocolate frosting 1. Mix well both boxes of pudding mix and milk. Add Cool Whip, set aside. 2. Line bottom of large dish with graham crackers.

3. Pour 1/2 pudding mixture on crackers, put another layer of crackers, balance of pudding, and top with a final layer of

graham crackers.
4. Heat can frosting in microwave for about 30 seconds and pour over top of crackers. Cool before putting cover on dish so frosting will not stick.
