## BATTER UP !!! THE BALLGAME HAS BEEN SCHEDULED

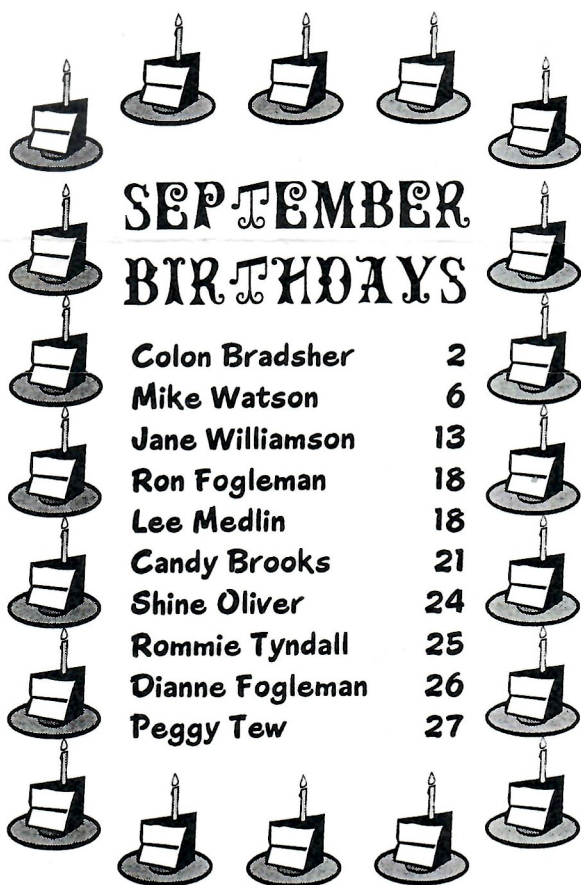
