Article IV - ORGANIZATION STRUCTURE

- C. Duties of the club officers
 - 3. Secretary

E. Currently reads: No member shall hold more than one (1) office at any one time. Officers of Burlington Shag Club Inc. shall not hold an office in any other shag club.

Add: Officers may serve no more than two consecutive years in the same capacity.

Add: All Presidents (retro-active to 1985) serving at least a twelve (12) month term will be made a life-time member of the club.
