

Requested Changes To Our Club By-Laws

The following amendments have been suggested for our club by-laws. These will be voted on at the March business meeting.

Article IV - ORGANIZATION STRUCTURE

- C. Duties of the club officers
 - 3. Secretary

Add: To disperse updated club member rosters to each officer and committee chairperson at each regular club meeting.

E. Currently reads: No member shall hold more than one (1) office at any one time. Officers of Burlington Shag Club Inc. shall not hold an office in any other shag club.

Add: Officers may serve no more than two consecutive years in the same capacity.

Add: All Presidents (retro-active to 1985) serving at least a twelve month term will be made a life-time member of the club.



From The Burlington Shag Club DJ Chairman

When Rick Turner became President in January, he asked me if I would schedule DJ's for the year 2002. Of course, I accepted, because I wanted to and he did this favor for me last year. I knew when I accepted this position, it would not be an easy task due to the fact that you can't please everyone all the time. Along with this duty, I was also given a restriction to schedule only 2 DJ's per month that the club pays for due to limited funds. I also set up some guide lines for myself to abide by. Some of these are: 1) schedule DJ's that have shown an interest in our club and expressed their desire to play, 2) try to have a variety, 3) schedule DJ's who appear to be playing to promote the shag, and 4) stay within the 2 DJ per month restriction. I will continue to try to follow these guide lines for the remainder of the year or until I am relieved of this duty.

The purpose of this article in in response to an issue that was brought before the club at the February meeting. I will not be able to attend the March meeting due to another commitment, so it seems appropriate to respond to the issue in the newsletter so the club members know my point of view. I understand that Roy Childress expressed an interest in playing on Friday nights. I do not understand why this issue was brought up at a meeting instead of contacting me. At the time of this writing, I am working with Roy to pick a date that he is not already booked.

It may appear that Rick and I are monopolizing Friday nights, but we only play one Friday night each month and we are playing for free to stay within the budget. I do not proclaim to be a DJ and will be the first to tell you that I am not a DJ. When I play, I have to admit I do have fun and enjoy it, but it is not something I have to do. So, if there is a DJ or DJ's out there who want my slot (normally the 1st Friday of each month), you can have it, but remember it does not pay anything but fun and the promotion of the shag dance. Any takers?

In an effort to keep variety, I will summarize the DJ's that have played since January 1st and are scheduled through June on our regular Friday night socials: one from Greensboro, three different DJ's from Durham, one from Eden, two different DJ's from Burlington, one from Topsail Island, one from Aiken, SC, one from Atlantic Beach, NC, and I'm also trying to schedule a DJ from Richmond, VA who has asked to play for our club.

In the future, if you want to DJ at our club, see me to schedule to play, don't DJ like it is a job and you're punching a time clock, and don't get offended if no one is dancing as soon as you start playing. I've come to the conclusion that most all shag clubs are the same, they are going to socialize before they dance, and last but not least, play to promote the shag dance and the music.
