Under:

VIII. Committees

Change: A.1.a. to: Chairperson to be appointed by the current President.

Tenure shall not exceed the term of the current President. The committee, Chairperson or any committee member

can be removed by the current President.

Change: A.1.b to: Is staffed by club members on a volunteer basis. When

more members volunteer than required, a drawing of names, from the list of volunteers, shall take place.

Ditto: A.2.a. and b.

> A.3.a. and b. A.4.a and b. A.5.a and b.

This is how they currently read:

- a) Is staffed by club members on a volunteer basis.
- b) Elects a chairperson and/or co-chairperson from the group.

Change: A.6.a. to: Chairperson to be appointed by the current President.

Tenure shall not exceed the term of the current President. The committee, Chairperson or any committee member can be removed by the current President.

A.6.b. to: Is staffed by club members (4 required) on a volunteer

basis and it's officers. When more members volunteer than required, a drawing of names, from the list of

volunteers, shall take place.


Item A. 6. Hall of Fame Committee currently reads:




