*Golf Committee* – Chuck Upchurch & Clint Sharpe, Co-Chairs – Meeting scheduled for May 22<sup>nd</sup> to finalize everything being handed over from Steve McHone to Chuck and Clint. Anyone interested in helping please let Chuck or Clint know. *Ways & Means Committee* – Steve McHone, Chair – SELL TICKETS for Area Party, these tickets are due a week before the event. The club needs to raise money so SELL, SELL, SELL!!! See Steve if you need tickets.

*Web Master* – Mary Gregory – Mary discussed a counting system that has been in place on the website for several months. She will try to get an article in the Shag Rag letting the club know what pages are being viewed and how often certain parts of the site are being looked at.

*Bus Trip Committee* - Denise & Chuck Upchurch, Co-Chairs – There will be no bus for the Eden Area Shag party. A caravan was suggested; call Chuck or Denise if interested.

*50/50 Committee* – Hugh Walker, Chair – Tickets will be sold at every business meeting going forward. Total amount for May meeting was \$75.00, the winner BUTCH DOWD went home with \$37.50.

Membership Committee - Carol Pettigrew, Chair - No Report

*Entertainment Committee* – Ronnie Gregory, Chair – Area Party is June 11<sup>th</sup> at the Moose Lodge in Burlington. Brown Bag is permitted, \$1.50 charge for setup and bottles have to be labeled with owner's name. Cost of beer is \$1.50 and wine is \$2.00, no coolers allowed. There has been good response from other clubs as to attendance. The Moose Lodge holds 450 people; we are looking for 300-350 to attend. Denise Upchurch is in charge of food items and the menu, let her know what you want to bring and she needs volunteers in helping getting everything set up. Be there 7-7:15 with food items, if you can't be there make other arrangements to get the food to the lodge. If possible have desserts prepared in single servings for convenience in serving. Joni James is in charge of decorations; she needs straw hats and Hawaiian shirts to put on the walls. If interested in helping with decorations be at the lodge around lunchtime.

Christmas Party: Will be held December 11<sup>th</sup>.....where to have it? Three possible locations:

- 1. Elks Lodge: approximate cost \$1775, smoking allowed, BYOB, no security cost and no bartender cost.
- 2. Ramada Inn: approximate cost \$1950, cash bar (club chooses bartenders), smoking allowed, food catered, security provided by the club, linen charge and located in Carolina/Duke room.
- 3. Quarry Hills Country Club: approximate cost \$2550, this included \$200/hr rental charge from the club to use the facilities. Cash bar provided, food catered and the club does not have to provide security.

Motion was made to have it held at Ramada and  $2^{nd}$ . Then a motion was made to vote on all three and  $2^{nd}$ . Since a motion was already on the floor the motion to vote on all three was cancelled. The membership present voted 27 to 6 in favor of

having it at the Ramada Inn. Next item of discussion was suggestions for the DJ at the Christmas Party. The nominations made were Johnny Wilson, Clyde Waller, Jerry Holland, Jim Waye and Tootie Brown. A motion was made to close nomination and  $2^{nd}$ . Nominations were closed and Sheila Walker will check with nominees to see about availability. She will report back to the membership at next business meeting.

BSC won the float contest for the 3<sup>rd</sup> year in a row and Stephanie West made the local paper. SOS Fall Migration will be held Sept. 17-24th, Joan Kimbro will be heading up Fun Monday so let her know if you are interested in helping out. The annual "Tea Party" came up for discussion...Hugh Walker suggested that we look at having it at the Pirate's Cove this year. A motion was made to have a "Tea Party" on Sept 17<sup>th</sup>, was 2<sup>nd</sup> and passed 27/1. Motion was then made to have it at Pirate's Cove and 2nd, there were several areas of concern and the motion was rescinded.
