3. Treasury Report - \$4,880.35. A printed report was handed out to members present. A treasury report for the upcoming ACSC Summer Workshop will be available at the next meeting.
4. Ronnie asked members to sign the book "Shag". He explained the E-bay information again and how the proceeds would be used. Asked members to also fill out the questionnaire.
5. Christmas Float - Ronnie spoke with Judy Lindley who is checking our information on the Burlington and Graham Christmas parades. Judy said it was too early to obtain information from the city, but she will continue to pursue it.

6. SOS Spring Parade Float - Pam McHone has t-shirts to sell - \$10.00 if you are not riding on the float and \$20 if you are riding. This will offset cost of the float. Shirts will be available up to parade time. See Pam to purchase one and you need to pay her by April 14th. Ronnie said members have been working very hard on this float. Any member who wants to participate should contact Baxter Sellars or Brenda Smith. Jim West gave a brief description of the float. Ronnie invited members to come to his house on Saturday afternoons to not only see the work in progress, but to donate some time to this fun project.

7. As a reminder, there will be not be a DJ for April 21 or 28 due to SOS.

8. To plan early, the Free Pour for Fall SOS was discussed. Voted on and passed were the following: A Free Pour will be held the first Saturday of Fall SOS (September 16th); \$500 will be allocated; and it will be held at the O.D. Arcade. Exact time will be announced later.

9. BSC "Area" Luau Party - June 10th - Moose Lodge. All information is on our web site. Ronnie said that Raleigh Shag Club has already advised him that they will be bringing a busload.

10. Steve McHone told us that Bogey's Sports bar will be having a golf tournament at Shamrock Golf Course on April 22nd. Steve asked that members of our shag club support this if possible.

11. Louise Flanigan advised that Alamance County Special Olympics had their Spring Games last week and an award was given to the Burlington Shag Club for our continuing support.

12. Steppin' Out Shaggin' Shag Club in Eden has their golf tournament scheduled for May 6th. Ronnie encouraged members to support their club's tournament if possible.

13. Eno Beach Shag Club "Area" Party is scheduled for May 20th. 50's Sock Hop theme. Please see Denise Upchurch if you want to ride on the bus. She needs to know by May 12th. Jim West said this was a fun trip and everyone should attend. There will be information on our web site and in the newsletter. DJs will be the Jellyrolls.

14. Mary Gregory gave a report on the ACSC Summer Workshop. Plans are moving along well. Members need to go ahead and fill our registration forms and send their money in. There will be five different free pours, sponsored by our club, Winston Salem Shag Club, and Steppin' Our Shaggin' Shag Club from Eden. All free pours and food will be at the Ramada Inn, the host hotel. Mary advised the Ramada is almost booked (editor's note: as of press time, the Ramada Inn is full). 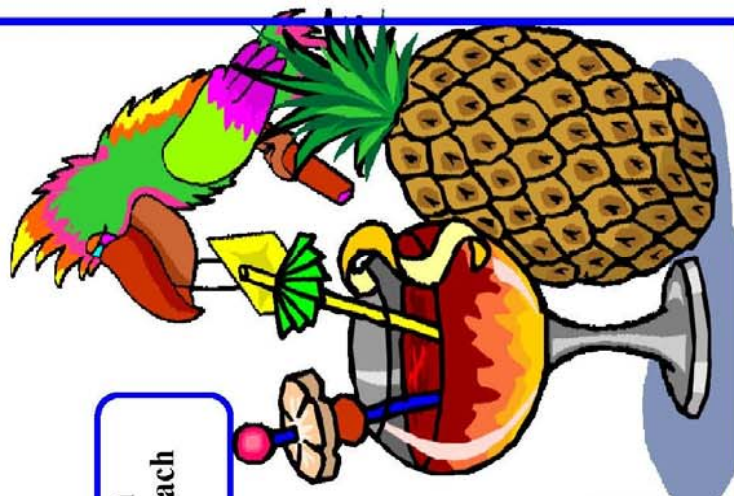

THEN turn left at 1st paved road (Service Road), follow that road until you see the Sign "Loyal Order Of Moose - Burlington Lodge No. 649" and turn right at that sign. The Moose will be at the end of that road.
