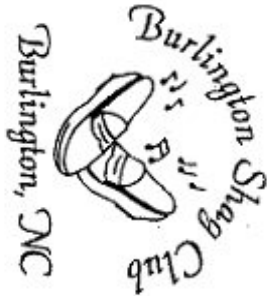

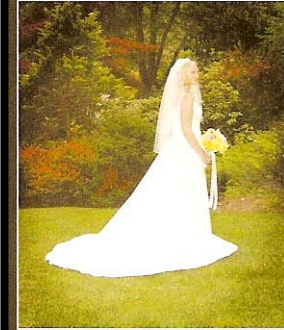

2. Secretary’s report –Minutes from the November business meeting was posted by Evelyn in the December newsletter. This report was approved as published. Current membership 239 members, with current renewals for 2007 at 92.
3. David Satterfield distributed and read the treasury report as of December 31st, 2006 – with an ending balance of \$11,847.73.
4. **Re-Up Party** – Carol Pettigrew reported that the Re-Up Party would be January 27th, 8 PM – 12 PM. Theme for the party is SPORTS. Please come dressed in your favorite sports attire. Party will be held at Masters. Carol contacted Bogey’s, 3-Thirty-3 Sports Bar and Masters. Bogey’s and 3-Thirty-3 declined to host the party. DJ will be Hugh Walker who volunteered his time. Each member will be given 2 tickets for beer, wine or choice of a designated mix drink or soft drink. Cut off time for redeeming tickets will be 9 PM. There will be a 50/50 and door prizes will be awarded as well.
5. **Shagging At The Mall** – will be held on February 2nd, 6 PM – 8 PM. David Tuttle has volunteered to serve as DJ. Jim asked all members to come out and dance and raise awareness for MOW and show the people of Alamance County what this club is all about.
6. **Meals On Wheels** – Ronnie Gregory reported that many members still had not purchased their tickets. They are now at the \$25 price. All tickets not sold and any money collected must be turned in to Ronnie by Friday, February 9th. Tickets sold the day of MOW – February 10th will be sold for \$30 each. As a reminder Coastline will be playing and the committees are working on lots of new ideas for this event. Committee chairs are Brenda Smith – Decorations, Denise Upchurch – Corporate Sponsors, Angie Sharpe – Silent Auction. These chairs need volunteers, please see them if you are available and interested in helping out.
 - a. **Silent Auction** – Angie reported that lots of great items are being donated. She asked that she be contacted so she can have all the donations prior to the day of MOW. If that’s not possible please bring your donations to the Duke Carolina Room at the Ramada. Angie also asked that members please consider a donation (i.e., unwanted items, baked goods, gift certificates)
 - b. **Decoration/Theme** – Brenda announced this year’s MOW will have the theme of STARS. A new addition to this year’s event is Dancing with the Stars. 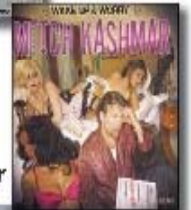

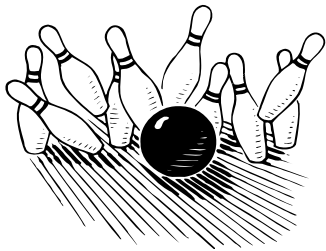
Mid-Winters

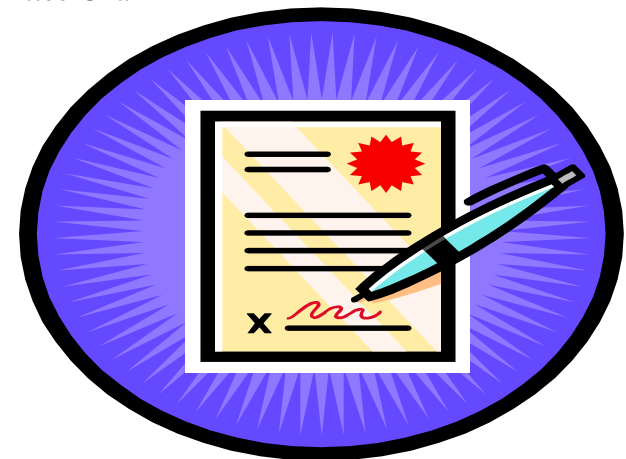
