**SOS Tea Party:** Joan stated that we had about 115 members present. The party was a great time with a lot of great comments from other clubs and people who were around us. We budgeted and spent \$700.00, with two generous members making anonymous donations to "keep the party going."

**Coalition Party:** There was a great turnout, with BSC being well represented. The weather was perfect. Burlington Shag Club will be co-hosting this party next year.

**Fun Monday:** Kim Caldwell stated that Fun Monday went really well, considering that we were the only shag club vendor there and that the crowd was smaller than recent years. We had budgeted \$1500.00 for merchandise and spent only \$1394.00. With the return of the booth fee and with the SOS store purchasing the remaining items at cost, we were left with a profit of \$784.00. Thanks for the great effort.

**ACSC Meeting:** Joan reported that they are having a contest for the Spring SOS parade theme. It will be the 17<sup>th</sup> year. Also, BSC received 3 checks at the meeting. They were for reimbursement of the booth fee for selling enough Fun Monday tickets, \$400.00 for attending all of the ACSC meetings and \$200.00 for selling the most Fun Monday tickets of any other club.

**Greensboro Area Party:** Burlington had 28 members attend and it was a fun evening.

**Special Olympics Golf Tournament:** Per Stephen Stearns, there were 29 teams with approx. net proceeds of \$6200. He doesn't have the final figure yet.

**Christmas Cheer Yard Sale:** Joan announced that some of the members were over there working on the set up for the yard sale scheduled for tomorrow from 7-12 at Stearns Ford. We want as much to be raised as possible, with hopes of adopting another 4 families this year.

**Christmas Party:** Joan brought up the issue with the locations for the Christmas Party. We had reserved the Carolina Room at Ramada and paid a non-refundable deposit of \$150.00. Leonard from the Moose Lodge called her this week to confirm that we would be having our party there for Christmas. They had previously told us that we could not have it there. In addition to the cost of the room at Ramada, we also have to pay \$120.00 for security and \$100.00 for a bartender, not to mention the high cost of food that we have to purchase from them. Because of the size of the room, our attendance would also be limited. If we change it to the Moose Lodge, we will lose the \$150.00 deposit, but the cost of the facility is \$450.00 plus \$100.00 for bartenders. Instead of an occupancy of 200 (Ramada), we could have 300 there and charge \$5.00 for admittance. We would be able to furnish our own food at much less cost than purchasing through Ramada. The overall costs should be reduced. Fred Hallaman made a motion to have the party at the Moose Lodge, with Cindy Sharpe seconding. Majority approved.


# HALLOWEEN PARTY 2010




