1. Kurt opened the meeting at 7:02. Meeting was held in the lounge due to a prior booking in the party room. Joan welcomed all members present.
2. Joan asked if there were any questions regarding the minutes of the January meeting which were printed in the latest newsletter. No comments were raised; Tim Wood motioned to accept; Doug Foley seconded, and minutes were approved.
3. Amy presented the Treasurer's Report noting final balance of \$12,504.50. Copies were given out to members. Janice McSherry motioned to accept; Kurt seconded, and report was approved.
4. Joan read the February birthdays.
5. Penny Rice read the Sunshine News. This information is printed elsewhere in this newsletter. Kurt Lankford thanked everyone on Lorna's behalf for their kindnesses during the time of her mother's passing.
6. Amy advised that members would not be working on the float tomorrow. She is waiting on supplies and other items. Will meet again next Saturday, Feb 28th at Mike's cabin. She also noted that we still need more sponsors.
7. Valentine Dance report was given by Joan. She thanked everyone for all their support and time put into this event to make it successful. Early on in the planning, Coastline advised they would make a contribution to Meals on Wheels and compensate the Burlington Shag Club for all the work put into the benefit. They donated \$4,548.72 to Meals on Wheels and \$1500 to our shag club. An additional \$1,260, which was \$820 raised from the entertainment and \$440 from the raffle, had been put into the shag club account in order to make a donation to Meals on Wheels. Janice made a motion that this be from BSC only. Amy thought that we should include Coastline also, but it was noted that the \$4548 donation was from them only. Lee Neese suggested that if we write a donation in the name of BSC that this might set a precedent of our club making special donations to charities, which we have not done before. Joan advised that she would transfer the \$1,260 amount to the benefit account and write check from there to go along with the other donation. Motion was made by Amy, seconded by Lucy, and approved to do this.
8. There was discussion of our club sponsoring an event on our own and there would need to be seed money for it. Mike Wilson suggested we take the \$1500 donation from Coastline and the \$650 raised in the 50/50 and put that in a special account. Debbie Burnham advised we should have a separate reserve account. Janice motioned to have a reserve account; Rick Burnham seconded, motioned was approved.
9. Luau plans need to be started. Joan asked if anyone wanted to be the chairman. Need to call a meeting soon.
10. SOS cruise raffle tickets – Joan has these if anyone is interested in buying one.
11. FUN Golf Tournament – Evelyn Turner advised this is scheduled for Saturday, April 4th. Special note that all payments will be made at the course, NO prepayments at all.
50/50 drawing - \$43 – won by Allen DuVall.
