The club raised \$18,764. with a profit of \$9,672.05 from ticket sales, DWTS entertainment, bake sale and silent auction. The auction brought in \$2,742 and the DWTS entertainment raised \$1600+. A motion was made to round out the money raised to split between our charities, Hospice and Palliative Care of Alamance-Caswell and Meals on Wheels, so each would receive \$5000. A motion was made by Lee Neese to use money from the Special Funds Account and seconded by Evelyn Turner. The motion was voted on by the members and passed. At the March 15 Business Meeting, checks will be presented to Hospice and MOW representatives. Also, Kim mentioned BSC has booked the 40 West Convention Center for our 2020 Valentine Dinner/Dance. The early bird gets the venue!!!


BSC Name Badges
