TREASURER'S REPORT (Kim Sellars) General Account and Fund-Raising Account deposits, expenses and balances were shared. A motion to accept the report was made by Jack Oakley and seconded by Dawn Lewis, motion passed.

MONTHLY BUSINESS MEETINGS (Kim Sellars) Monthly Business Meetings are held at Rack and Rolls 7:00-8:00 followed by dancing with our DJ. Next business meeting will be October 15th due to SOS.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS' REPORT (Jack Oakley vice chair) Jack reported that the board discussed upcoming SOS, appointed a bylaw committee chair, and discussed upcoming club elections.

SOS REPORT (Jack Oakley vice chair) Fall ion SOS 17-26th is still on unless State of South Carolina shuts it down. On Wednesday Sept 22 at 12 Noon there will be a Patriotic Tribute located on the beach at Ashworth/ OD Resort. There will also be a Celebration of Life on Wednesday September 22nd at 6pm at the Horseshoe featuring special guests Gary Lowder and Christina Black. SOS 2020 tickets are still good. There will not be a Fun Sunday or Fun Monday.

Old Business:

Bylaw Committee (Jack Oakley) Jack reported that he had been appointed chair of the bylaw committee by the board. He requested members to contact him with any concerns about bylaws for the committee to review. The first meeting will be Tuesday Sept 14th at 6pm.

2021 SOS Fall Migration Script Party (Kim Sellars) The script party is scheduled for Thursday Sept 23rd 6-8pm at the OD Arcade. Five-dollar scripts will be given to BSC club members to toward drinks, food, or merchandise only during the designated time of 6-8pm. The scripts are not good after 8pm.

2021 Halloween Party Friday Oct 29th (Kim Sellars reported for Brenda Smith, chair). The Halloween party will start at 8pm (not 7pm) to allow time for the committee to decorate and party goers to dress up in costumes. There will be food and prizes for the best costume. DJ is Dominick Furman.

2021 New Year's Eve Friday Dec 31st (Kim Sellars) Kim reported she is chairing this event to be held at Rack N Rolls. DJ is Randal Hight.

2021 Christmas Saturday Dec 4th (Darlene Oakley chair). The Christmas party committee has met and working on plans for the party at Burlington Shrine Club. Tickets are on sale at Friday Shag nights. Tickets must be purchased in advance. Deadline for purchase is November 24th. Tickets are \$25 for members, \$35 for non-members. Filet mignon or chicken meal must be chosen at ticket purchase and cannot be changed. Brown bagging is permitted with \$1 setups, \$3 beer and wine. The contract requires that we purchase a minimum of 60 meals.

New Business:

AED (heart defibrillator) (Kim Sellars) The AED cabinet, wall sign, and new pads have been purchased by Darlene Oakley and installed by Jack. Darlene has created a monthly log sheet to document battery function and pad expiration. Kim contacted Bud Catoe to schedule CPR and AED training for a Saturday. Kim passed around a sign up.

Christmas Cheer (Kim Sellars) Kim reported she had taken a load of items that had been placed in the BSC collection buckets on Friday Nights to Betty Hall, Christmas Cheer Director. Kim stated that Christmas Cheer has no government funding, and that 100 percent of donations go to the community. Last year they helped 510 families, 1311 children and 150 elderlies. In addition to items listed in the BSC newsletter, Christmas Cheer needs volunteers to deliver items. Kim passed around a sheet for volunteers.

Boston Butt Fundraiser (Kim Sellars) Kim asked if the club is interested in having a Boston Butt sale Saturday November 19th to benefit the club general fund. It is anticipated that club membership will be down and revenue from January reup may be lower. Jack made a motion to hold a Boston Butt fundraiser for the club general fund on November 19th. Baxter seconded. Motion passed.

Nominating committee (Lee Neese) Lee asked if all nomination forms had been turned in. He called for 4 volunteers for the nominating committee. Change #1: (page 4)

IV. ORGANIZATION STRUCTURE

E. Duties of the club officers:

2. Vice-President

~~b. To chair the Ways and Means committee. Tenure shall not exceed the term of the current President. The committee, chairperson, or any committee member can be removed by the current Board of Directors.~~

b. To assist the President and other officers in other duties as requested.

Change #2: (page 5)

VI. VOTING

A. A properly deemed voting body would constitute a minimum of ~~five percent (5%)~~ of the total club current membership, plus a minimum of three officers, at any club meeting.

A. A properly deemed voting body would constitute a minimum of **ten percent (10%)** of the total club current membership, plus a minimum of three officers, at any club meeting.

B. All votes will be decided by a majority of the members present.

C. A motion will not be voted on until the next month's business meeting if it includes expenditure not in the approved annual budget and greater than \$500.

D. In respect to the election of officers, newly-elected officers shall have received a majority of the votes cast for each office.

E. A member must have joined the club prior to August 1st in order to be eligible to cast a vote in the election of officers in November.

F. Members must be in attendance at the November business meeting in order to vote.

1. To have **each** chairperson appointed by the current President. Tenure shall not exceed the term of the current President. **Any** committee, chairperson, or any committee member can be removed by the current Board of Directors.

2. To be staffed by club members on a voluntary basis. When more members volunteer than required, a drawing of names from the list of volunteers shall take place.

~~3. To plan and implement, after approval of the members at the general meeting, all club's functions, such as the Area Shag Club Party, Christmas Party, Halloween Party, and any other event they would like to present.~~

3. To plan and implement the Area Shag Club Party, Christmas Party, Halloween Party, New Year's Eve Party, or any other club function/event approved by the members at the general meeting.

4. To see that tickets, if used for said event, are available and distributed to the club members for sale. This includes tracking of the ticket numbers, if required. Club members will volunteer to sell tickets.

5. To disperse complimentary tickets awarded to Hall of Fame members and Past Presidents for the following special functions: Annual Christmas Party and Area Shag Club Party.

6. To be responsible for choosing a DJ for the specific event.

E. Nomination Committee

4. To have chairperson poll the slate of nominees for their acceptance during the October business meeting. Nominees must be present to accept, unless emergency situations arise. If the nominee cannot attend the October business meeting and wishes to accept the nomination, they must notify the chairperson prior to the meeting with the reason for their absence. The chairman will read the reason for their absence to the membership at the October business meeting. ~~If there are no objections,~~ the chairman will accept their nomination and their name will be placed on the ballot.

4. To have chairperson poll the slate of nominees for their acceptance during the October business meeting. Nominees must be present to accept, unless emergency situations arise. If the nominee cannot attend the October business meeting and wishes to accept the nomination, they must notify the chairperson **in writing** prior to the meeting with the reason for their absence. The chairman will read the reason for their absence to the membership at the October business meeting. **The membership will vote on whether to accept the nomination of the absent nominee. If the majority is in favor,** the chairman will accept their nomination and their name will be placed on the ballot. **If a nomination committee member accepts a nomination, they must step down from the committee and the first alternate will be seated.**

1. To have chairperson appointed by the current President. Tenure shall not exceed the term of the current President. The committee, chairperson, or any committee member can be removed by the current Board of Directors.

2. To be staffed ~~by club members,~~ four (4) required and two (2) alternates, on a voluntary basis. When more members volunteer than required, a drawing of names from the list of volunteers shall take place. Drawing of volunteer names shall take place during the September business meeting. Alternates ~~would~~ attend meetings but ~~would~~ not vote unless seated.

2. To be staffed **by former officers and Hall of Fame inductees,** four (4) required and two (2) alternates, on a voluntary basis. When more eligible members volunteer than required, a drawing of names from the list of volunteers shall take place. Drawing of volunteer names shall take place during the September business meeting. Alternates **will** attend meetings but **will** not vote unless seated.

3. To receive properly endorsed nominations (on the club's nomination form) by October 1st.

4. To have all committee members review, ~~screen, and verify the forms to ensure eligibility and criteria have been met.~~ No more than one (1) person shall be selected for induction in any given year.

4. To have all committee members review **and score nominees using the Hall of Fame evaluation / selection rubric to ensure that eligibility and minimum criteria have been met. A minimum score of 20 points out of a highest possible score of 40 points is required.** No more than one (1) person shall be selected for induction in any given year.

5. To preserve the integrity and honor of the HOF, as well as the BSC, ~~the committee member volunteer will step down if he/she is nominated.~~ The first alternate will be seated.

5. To preserve the integrity and honor of the HOF, as well as the BSC, **any person (committee volunteer or current officer) will step down from attending HOF meetings and HOF voting if nominated.** The first alternate will be seated.

6. To have confidentiality remain within the committee. **Hall of Fame evaluation / selection rubrics are completed in secret with the nominee with the highest accumulative score** to be inducted based on the following criteria:
 - a. Must hold past or current Burlington Shag Club membership.
 - b. Must be fifty (50) years old or older.
 - c. Must have distinguished themselves in the 'shag world' for a minimum of five (5) years in three (3) of the four (4) following categories:
 - 1) Distinguished service for the Burlington Shag Club and/or the ACSC/SOS.
 - 2) Distinguished service as an officer and/or committee chairperson of the Burlington Shag Club and/or ACSC/SOS.
 - 3) Regular attendance and participation in the Burlington Shag Club and/or ACSC/SOS.
 - 4) Distinguished service as a (shag) instructor, **shag dance** competitor in local, area, or national shag competitions, **DJ, or creator of major event.**
7. To meet (after screening of all nominations by the volunteer committee) with the officers by October 31st to review, discuss, and ~~vote on inductees.~~
7. To meet (after screening of all nominations by the volunteer committee) with the officers by October 31st to review, discuss, and **complete Hall of Fame evaluation / selection rubrics. Completed rubrics will be submitted to chairperson to tally the scores. In the event of a tie, the HOF selection team will review the nomination forms of the tied nominees and vote by secret ballot.**
8. To recognize all nominees and announce new inductee at the November business meeting.
9. To make inductee a lifetime member of the Burlington Shag Club.
10. To recognize the new inductee by their name being added to the club's Hall of Fame plaque.
11. To honor the new inductee with a special ceremony during the Burlington Shag Club Christmas Party.
