PRESIDENT'S REMARKS - (Kim Sellars) welcomed everyone to the meeting.

SECRETARY'S REPORT - (Karen Byrd) Minutes from the May meeting were published in the newsletter. Jack moved that we accept and Amber seconded and the membership approved. The total membership count is 248. June and July BIRTHDAYS were shared!

TREASURER'S REPORT - (Jerry Byrd), shared the balances of the General Account and the Fund Raiser Account. These figures were shared with all and any questions were answered. Motion to accept the Treasurer's Report was made by Karen and seconded by Jack Oakley. The motion passed.

SUNSHINE REPORT - (Debbie Burnham) Debbie shared concerns/prayers for specific club members. See NL for details.

MONTHLY BUSINESS MEETING - The next business meeting will be July 15, 2022.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS' REPORT - Jack Oakley, BOD Chairman, reported that the BOD met June 6, 2022. Committee chairs were reviewed. The topic of DJ pay was discussed. We are the lowest paying club in the area @ \$25/hr. He presented numbers to the membership showing that for this year, we cannot consider raising the pay because we will have a deficit of about \$3500. This does not include income from the parade and 50/50 and assumes that our parties will break even. One suggestion from the board was to change the meeting hour from 7 to 8 on Friday nights. The membership would have to vote on this and no one made a motion to entertain this option. The BOD is discussing options for additional ways to increase revenue. Please share any ideas. Members are encouraged to tip the DJ, especially for requests. A bucket will be provided. Tips have been running between \$0-\$75 each night. The next BOD Meeting will be July 11, 6:00 pm. Members were encouraged to reach out for any concerns.

Tickets will be available for the raffle. Ducks will be participating more this time. The float prize money was discussed. Concern from members was discussed because the money was given directly to the HOF instead of coming back to the club. Realizing that this was not voted on, a vote was held and passed to let the money stay with the HOF but that in the future, the money will go to the General Fund and disbursement would be voted on prior to a donation. Several members expressed concerns about the budget. Questions were answered by board members. Ron Gregory made a suggestion that there be a focused discussion about the budget and to answer any concern the membership may have. Cards for SOS are still available.

DANCE LESSONS – Darlene Oakley reported that Beginner lessons started again on June 3. Creating revenue of \$1701.

LUAU – This was held on June 12th from 2-6 pm at Baxter's. Gary Lowder & Smokin Hot was the band and Chigger Woods was DJ. The cost is \$10 for the band only. A meal ticket is an additional \$12. Attendance at Baxter's was 255. The caterer changed to Country Barbecue and was delicious. Net profit was \$454.37.

2022 BENEFIT EVENT – Amber Allen reported that there will be a Car Show August 13 @ Rack and Rolls, 11am-2pm. There will be vendors inside and 3 food trucks, 2 food and one coffee. Contact Buddy if you would like to enter a car. Entries are \$20. There will be a 50/50 and door prizes. She reported that a location has been selected for the second event. It will be held at Woodside Farm for September 10th from 4-10 pm. The theme will be Hibernation Celebration. There will be an afternoon of various contests. Tickets will be \$30, all inclusive. On July 11, reservations for a table will be available for \$350. Furman Dominick will DJ. Food will be BBQ, beans and slaw. There will be a gun raffle for a 22 Winchester. Tickets are \$10 each or 5 for \$40. There will be a shuttle to the hotel.

COALITION REPORT – Kim Sellars reported the dates for parties for our sister clubs. Winston Salem Sock hop is Saturday, June 25. GTSC 10/29 and Danville 11/12.




