**BUSINESS MEETING** June 14, 2024

Ambeer Allen welcomed everyone and called meeting to order at 6:30 pm PRESIDENT'S REMARKS -(Amber Allen) requested that everyone to please sign in. Sign in sheets available at each entrance.

SECRETARY'S REPORT – (Debbie Burnham) Everyone was asked if they had an opportunity to read the minutes in the last newsletter and if no questions could we get a motion to accept. Sherry Laughlin made a motion to accept – Janice McSherry 2nd - all approved

TREASURER'S REPORT – (Gerald Scarlett) Shared the balances of the General Account and the Special Account. Explaining the error that was in previous statement and the correction. Janice McSherry had concerns about how the Special Fund account was being used and asked if we could have an additional report on what was being used for events and if we could separate the reimbursements on spreadsheets. Amber answered that she would have Scott Loy(treasurer) to do a separate listing of those funds from the Special Event Account to have a clearer picture for members. Amber Allen noted some money has been spent on Valentine Party and Reverse Raffle for 2025 Motion to accept the Treasurer's Report was made by Kim Dawson and 2nd by Kim Sellars. All approved.

## **BOARD OF DIRECTORS' REPORT -**

Buddy Richardson- reviewed the board's recommendations to take \$697 and deposit it into the general fund. Reason was due to membership is down and still looking at \$3500 for Dj's to finish up 2024. Buddy then asked for a motion. Janice McSherry spoke up about the expenses that we are looking at to finish out this year and that this is no other fund raisers to help offset what is needed. Her main question concerning this event which was first presented to the membership was to be a fundraiser for the club so when did it become a charity event? Amber responded that it was to be a fundraiser with 10% to go to the club. Gerald also commented on how the funds was to be dispensed and was in favor of the club receiving a portion from the Reverse Raffle. Janice gave other examples of cost for Hall of Fame and past Presidents being able to come to the Luau and Christmas party that the club is responsible for paying for. Janice then made the suggestion that 50% be given to the club's General Fund and 50% to a single charity, that was her motion. Gerald Scarlett 2nd the motion. Lucy Duvall ask for clarification on the wording on flyers if it is to be a fundraiser or charity event. Kim Dawson added to the conversation that she had asked the same question and it was determined that the Reverse Raffle was a fundraiser. Gerald said going forward it will need specific wording so there will be no questions on how the funds will be allocated. Kim Sellars suggested that the committee make the decision on future charities ahead of time so membership is clear on what is being recommended. Amber called for a vote with 50% to the club and a single charity which was voted on and passed. Each member was given a ballot and The Denise Marie Flaherty Memorial (DMF) will receive from BSC a check for \$4348.00

Luau – June 22nd - The Burlington Shrine Club. \$45 a person includes chicken or steak dinner and open bar. Chigger Woods will be the DJ Kim Dawson gave update - meeting June 20th to put baskets together 6 pm at R & R. tickets being sold for the liquor basket. Junior Shaggers Event – this event will be held at Thataways in Burlington on August 3rd– with the City of Burlington co-sponsoring this event. This will bring kids ages - walking to 21 - together to learn the shag steps. 3pm - 7 pm Hoping to have 50 young adults to participate - please spread the word.

Special Olympics Golf Tournament – October 11th -Indian Valley Golf Course. Cayce Lineberry is the Chairperson Looking for sponsors now. Still looking for Sponsors would like to have 125. Details on t-shirt and food for participants.

Fun Monday Tickets - will be for sale after the Luau.

Janice McSherry asked to speak about the Special Fund Event Account, Account was set up to cover the Valentine Dance to maintain a balance of 10,000. And why was this account being used to fund other events. Amber said additional research would be needed before her questions could be answered, but a reminder to everyone that for several years we did not do this event

The meeting was adjourned by Amber at 7:09pm.



# Did You Know?

The Charitable Foundation (aka Charitable Trust) The Charitable Trust is a 501c3 organization that receives its funding from proceeds of the Fun Monday event held each year at Fall SOS. What ever is left over from the cost of putting on Fun Monday goes into the Charitable account of the Charitable Trust.


The Shag Clubs of ACSC are main sources of selling the Fun Monday tickets at \$10 per ticket. There is a drawing during Fun Monday with the 2024 grand prize being \$5,000. Second place receives \$1,000, third place \$500, and fourth and fifth place \$250. Other tickets can be purchased on the streets during the event. There have been some clubs that do not or will not sell these tickets. There are a number of great ways for our ACSC clubs to be successful with this important project! The Charitable Trust for this most current meeting held during Spring SOS voted to give \$12,000 in \$2,000 amounts to 6 great organizations. These are the Hall of Fame Foundation, SOS Care, Special Olympics, Junior Shag Association, Horry County Rescue, and the Tunnels To Towers organization. It is of great significance that following the deaths of 4 police officers in Charlotte, that Tunnels To Towers announced that they would be paying off the mortgages of the surviving families of these slain officers. We hope to make more donations, with some of them being via the application process that we are going to do a better job of making available through the SOS website.

Updates to the website will be coming soon! It is important to understand that not only do these Fun Monday tickets provide fantastic entertainment on the first Monday of Fall Migration, but also the chance to win a sizable monetary prize, and to help contribute a sizable donation to worthy charities on local and national levels. Many of our Shag Clubs are wonderful about donations to charities, and this is another way for them to meet their goals. We need the kindness of all the ACSC Shag Clubs to support this effort. Once the Fun Monday costs are paid, the substantial remaining balance will be used for the charities. Shag Clubs, individuals, and corporate entities can sponsor Fun Monday at specific levels of donations, which can be a tax deduction for those entities. The levels are \$250, \$500, \$750, \$1,000, and more if interested. This information can be found at Shagdance.com under the Fun Monday link with all the details. The Board of the Charitable Trust will be making a document to assist you in successful ways to sell Fun Monday tickets. The ideas will come from the most successful clubs who sell Fun Monday tickets. We will choose ideas from both big and small clubs. We look forward to assisting your efforts in any way that we can!
