Weeks before, a few people got the idea of a shag club and decided that the first thing to do would be to get a board of directors. First, we had to have a home base, and, naturally, Best Western came to mind. We sat down with Best Western management, and management agreed to let the facility become our home base. We would continue having beach music every Saturday night, and the Burlington Triad Shag Club would sponsor special Friday night events and future dance contests.

At the first board meeting on August 3, the board decided to name the club Burlington Triad Shag Club rather than Burlington Shag Club in hopes that shaggers in surrounding cities would feel more a part of the club.

Officers were elected at the second board meeting on Saturday, August 24. We had to have a slate of officers before we could get a taxpayer's identification number, necessary to open a checking account in our club name. It was decided that the first slate of officers would come from the board of directors, the group that founded the club. 
The club's checking account will be at Graham Savings and Loan, which will not charge the club a monthly checking fee.

SPONSORS - As of August 31, we have 39 sponsors for the Burlington Triad Shag Club, eight personal sponsors (members willing to donate items for special events) and so far, two occasional sponsors. Check the list at Best Western for these names. We plan to add several more businesses to our sponsor list before we close out. These sponsors will be listed inside our membership cards and will offer you at least a 10% discount when you go into their business to make a purchase. If any of you know a business that you think may be interested or willing to become a sponsor, ask hem. MEMBERSHIP CARDS - We want to get several more sponsors before we print our membership cards, but this will be done very soon. Our cards will be drivers license size, fold-over, with our sponsors' names printed inside. These cards will be numbered and will be effective until December 31, 1986. We have a couple of events planned between now and Christmas whereas Burlington Triad Shag Club members only can attend. Also, we will have "party fees" at the door on occasions, and members will not have to pay.
