#### A Little Stutter Step

The Shag....when did it really start and where...I would say no one really knows! Here is one story that I found very interesting...it touches the "when" but not the "where"!

On the cover of LIFE magazine for the week of August 23, 1943 (that's right 1943) there was a picture of a young couple doing what was called the "Lindy Hop". The young man, on the cover, was 17 at the time.

Some years later that same young man, wrote an article telling how he happened to end up on the cover of LIFE. The young man's name was Stanley Catron. Some of you may know that name. He has attended SOS's.

At the time, Catron was working in a musical comedy called "Something for the Boys", as a chorus boy. The "Big" star was Ethel Merman; and the music was written by Cole Porter. The odd thing was that this musical was the only one Porter ever wrote that did not produce a hit song!

Like all new actors, moonlighting was a way of life and Catron was no different..he was working as a model. One day, his agent called and asked him to do a photography session with Gjon Mili. Mili was working with strobe speed photography. The session was to be on the dance of the day, "Lindy Hop" and as luck would have it, his female partner, like so many of us...had trouble putting her feet down in the correct order...could not dance a step!

Stan talked with the LIFE editor and explained this would not work unless they had someone who could do the dances of the day, Lindy, **Shag**, Boogie and Shorty George (?).

So, was the Shag around in 1943? In New York? It sounds like it was! Heaven forbid, was it a northern dance?

Stan found his own partner from the chorus of the musical he was in. The next morning they started the session...since it was action photography they had to dance the full session! The record they danced to was "Cotton Tail", by Lucky Millinder. Can't say I've ever heard it but from Stan's words, it sounds a little quick!

World War II put Stan's acting career on the back burner. Somehow it just stayed there. But on the bright side, he met and married Betty Kirkpatrick ("Kirk"), one of the early Shag Hall of Famers!
