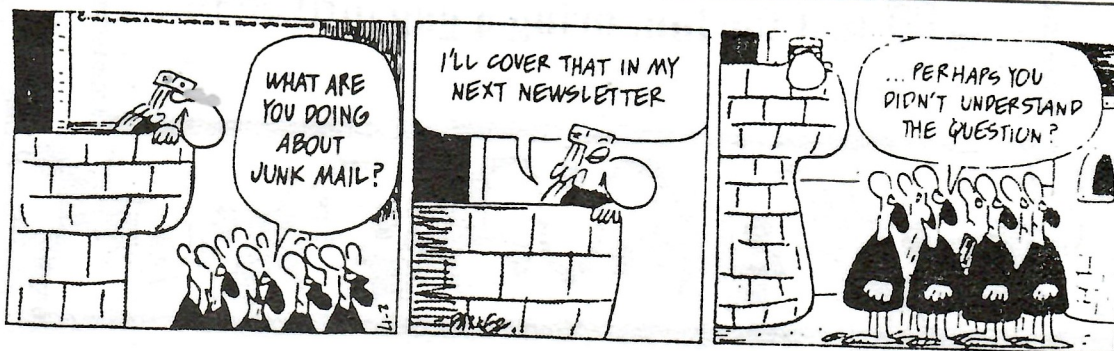
What it costs to print and mail 155 newsletters to 180 members:
