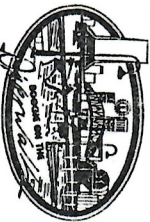

I will begin my news article with a profound statement:

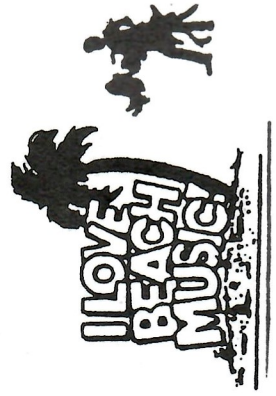
Throwdown II at Ducks & Ducks Too was FANTASTIC!!

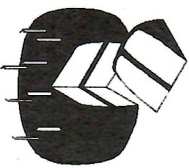

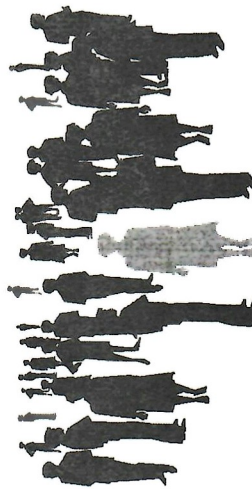

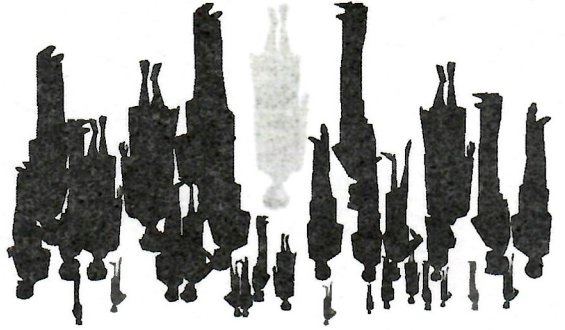
