## THE DJ CORNER

(Reprinted from the Florence Shag Club's April, 1993, newsletter.)

One of our members asked me to discuss DJ jargon in relationship to categories of Shag music. The following categories are the one's that I (and most Shag DJs) use.

Traditional (Commercial) Shag - The "Standards" (Ms. Grace, Rainy Day Bells and Little Red Book) are good examples. Dan E. Lockamy plays a lot of Traditional Shag music on his Saturday beach show.

Disco Shag - This category of shag music has a distinctive disco beat. The forerunner in this category is Heaven Must Be Missing An Angel by Tavares. Gonna Get Along Without You Now by Viola Wills is another example.

Rhythm and Blues - Needs no definition. Big Joe Turner and B. B. King stand tall in this category.

Cowboy Shag - The county influence. Reba McEntire's Walk On and Tanya Tucker's Down To My Last Teardrop are good examples.

Contemporary Shag - Top 40 type music. The Bee Gee's Happy Ever After and Michael Bolton's Love Is A Wonderful Thing are good examples.

You might not know the name of the song, but I'm sure that you have a favorite category. So, just ask your DJ to play some Cowboy Shag music or some Disco Shag music. I'm sure that he or she will know what you're talking about.
