What is a Paver Block?
Each Paver Block contains: 110 - 4"x8" individual "Shagger's Paviers" and 1 - 16"x16" "Shag Club Paver" (see illustration opposite page).

Your Name Here!

"Shagger's Paver"

The 4"x8" "Shagger's Paver" is for the individual members of your shag club and each paver will be inscribed with a club members name (Maximum-two lines text per paver/13 characters per line). For each paver sponsor, a special "Shagger's Walk Of Fame" certificate will be sent to you which reflects your paver inscription.

"Shag Club Paver"

The 16"x16" "Shag Club Paver" sets in the center of each of your club's Paver Blocks associating you with your shag club's Name, City and State (shag club logo may be included).

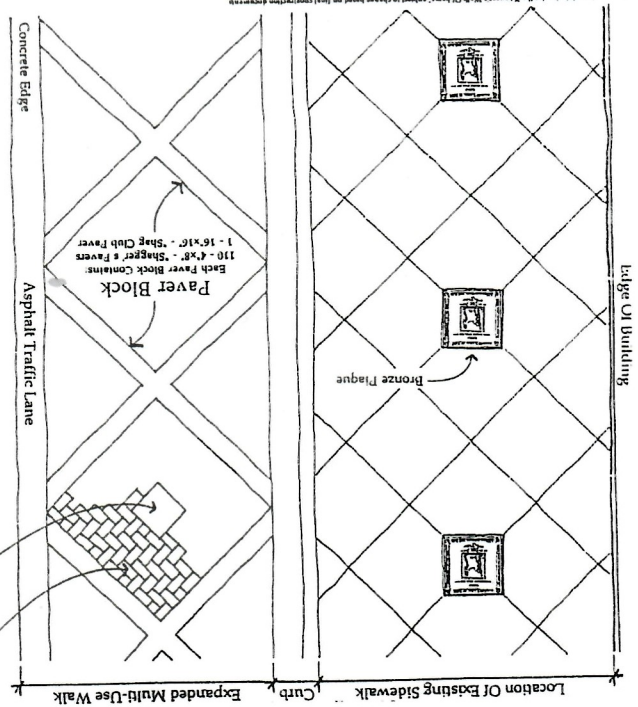
How many Paver Blocks will your shag club need?

To figure this out, look at the following example:

- Say the OD Shag Club has 1100 members
- 1100 Members divided by 110 Shagger's Paviers = 10 Paver Blocks.

Your shag club will be responsible for the purchase of each Paver Block needed and will then coordinate the collection for your "Shagger's Paver" (tax deductible). Just because you don't have enough club members to fill a Paver Block or two doesn't preclude you from filling it up in the future. Paver inscriptions will be made on site after the initial installation of the Paver Blocks, and also in the future to engrave the names of new members. In addition to having club members in your Paver Block, you may want to recognize your shag club's honorees (past, present and future) with individual pavers which have their name, their accomplishment and the date. eg: National Shag Champion-1990, Club President-1993, etc.

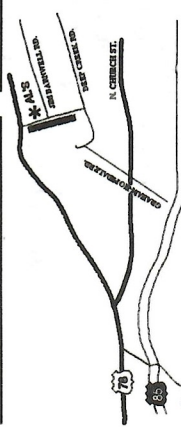

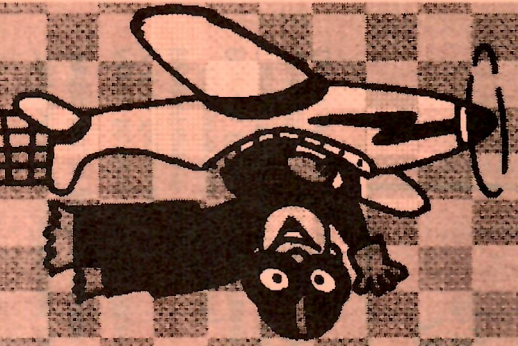

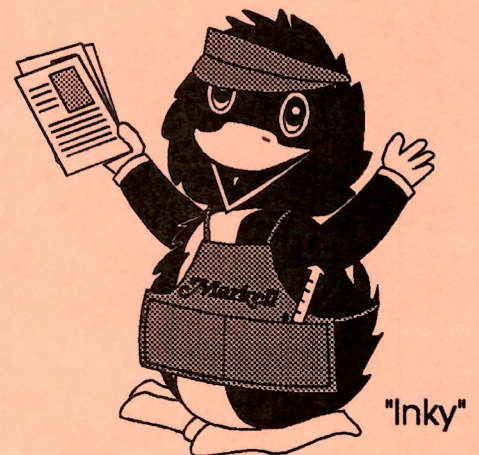
