

**Reba McEntire's Best
Yogurt Chicken**

- 1 cup lowfat plain yogurt
- ½ cup fresh lemon juice
- 1 teaspoon curry powder
- 1 teaspoon cumin
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1 to 2 garlic cloves, minced
- 4 large boneless skinless chicken breast halves

In small bowl, combine all ingredients except chicken; mix well. Score top of chicken by making shallow cuts, about 1/8 to 1/4 inch deep. Place chicken in zipper-topped plastic bag; add yogurt mixture. Turn or gently shake bag until chicken is coated. Let stand at room temperature for 15 minutes.

Spray broiler pan with nonstick cooking spray. Place chicken on spray-coated pan; brush with yogurt mixture. Broil 4 to 6 inches from heat for 6 to 8 minutes. Turn chicken; brush with mixture. Broil an additional 7 to 9 minutes or until chicken is fork tender and juices run clear. Discard any remaining yogurt mixture.

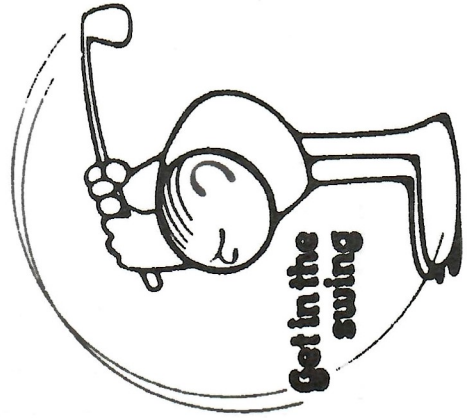

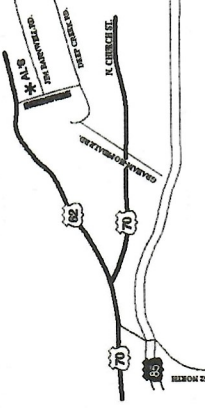

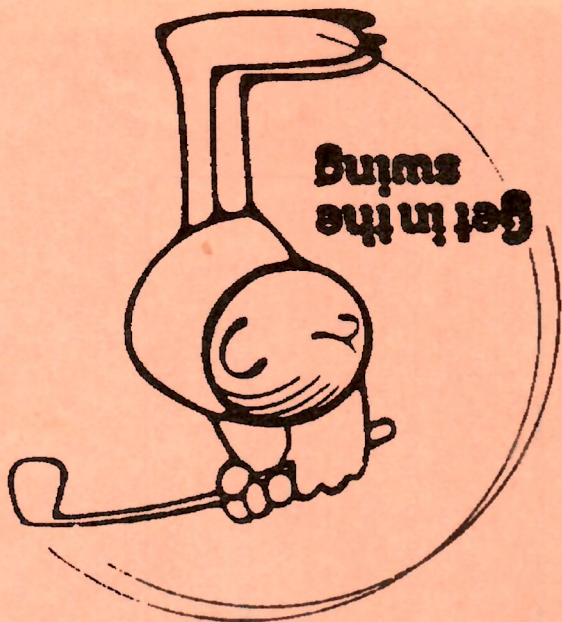
