Elsewhere in this newsletter I mentioned something about Debbie Baynard, lounge manager at Best Western, offering us the use of the lounge on Friday nights. Since Debbie moved from Ramada Inn, many of us have wondered whether we would still have a home at Ramada Inn. Bob Maccia has talked to Robin Thomas, motel manager at Ramada Inn. She has assured us that they want us to stay and they will still be hiring DJs for our weekly dances, but there is a possibility of asking us to move our weekly night to Saturday. There was no admission charge to any location or event, and free food and spirits were plentiful.

Many shaggers got their first introduction to the Barn Restaurant at the Throwdown. Owner Pat Anderson loves shaggers, and hosts the monthly meetings of M.A.S.S. in the banquet room (entire upstairs of the restaurant) at no charge. Three cheers for Pat! The M.A.S.S. members recently installed a fantastic permanent oak dance floor, much to the delight of all who partied there. Those who chose to order a meal at the Barn can also attest to why it has earned a reputation as the undisputed epitome of fine dining in an area rightly famous for its gourmet restaurants.

Bucky and Sandra Hendrix of M.A.S.S. coordinated the Inland Throwdown Special Olympics Golf Tournament, which was a huge success. After all, why not play golf when you are in the golf capital of North Carolina? The cost was minimal, and great fellowship was enjoyed by all who participated (even those who had to make up all those excuses for why they had such a bad day).

Kudos to M.A.S.S. for pulling off the sleeper event of the year! Special thanks to Chuck and Shirley Ward, John Womack, Bobby Brooks and all the hard-working M.A.S.S. members who made this party an overwhelming success. I can't wait to see what they do for next year. Whatever it is, be assured that this event will be on my permanent calendar! If you didn't attend this year, you have an excuse. If you don't attend next year, don't admit it.

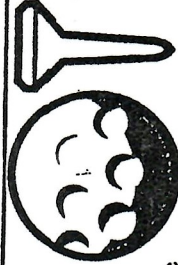

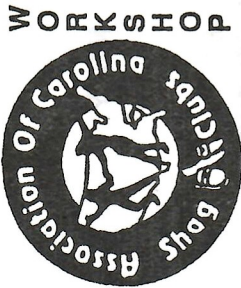

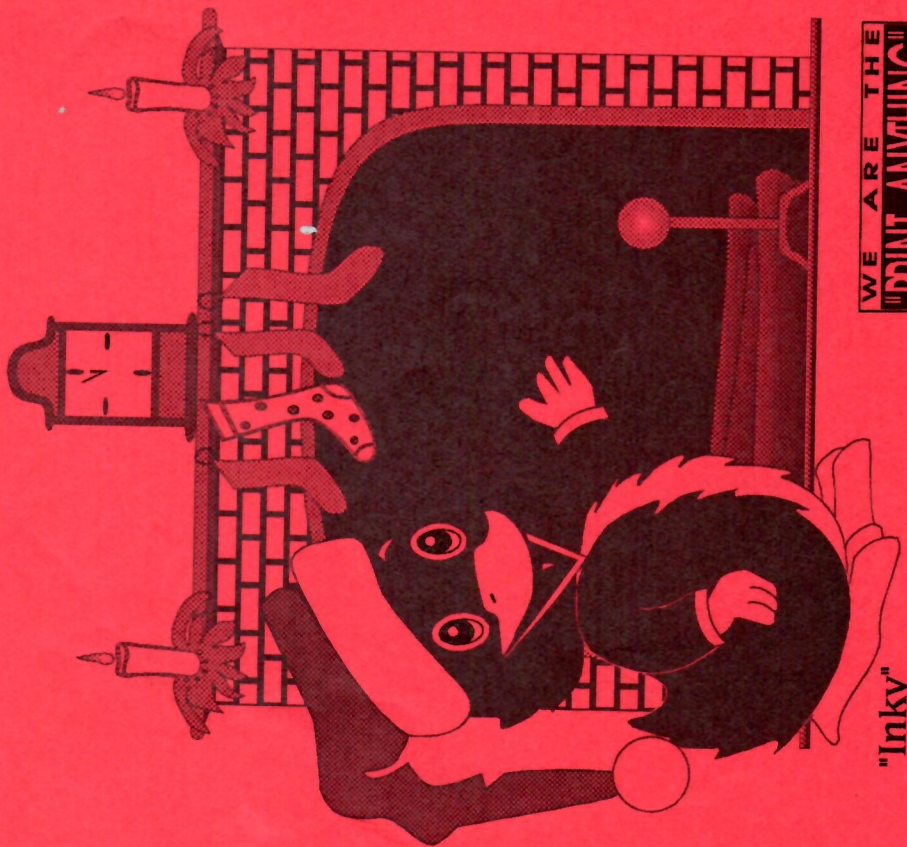
