COMMIT to your club. Believe in it more than anybody else.

SHARE your enthusiasm with your fellow members and treat them as partners. In turn, they will treat you as a partner and together you will all perform beyond your wildest expectations.

MOTIVATE your fellow members. Constantly, day by day, think of new and more interesting ways to motivate and challenge your fellow members. Set high goals and strive to attain those goals. If things get stale, cross-pollinate, have Chairpersons switch jobs with one another to stay challenged. Keep everybody guessing as to what your next trick is going to be. Don't become predictable.

COMMUNICATE everything you possibly can to your fellow club members. The more the members know, the more they'll understand. The more the members understand, the more they will care. Information is power, and the gain you get from empowering your fellow members more than offsets the risk of informing your competitors.

APPRECIATE everything your fellow members do for the club. All of us like to be told how much somebody appreciates what we do for them. Nothing else can quite substitute for a few well-chosen, well-timed sincere words of praise. They're absolutely free - and worth a fortune.

CELEBRATE your successes. Find some humor in your mistakes and failures. Don't take everything so seriously. Loosen up and everybody around you will loosen up. Have fun. Show enthusiasm - always.

LISTEN to your fellow members and figure out ways to get them talking. The folks on the Board of Directors are the only ones who actually know what's going on. You'd better find out what they know. This is really what total quality is all about. To push responsibility down in your club, and to force good ideas to bubble up within it, you **MUST** listen to what your fellow members are trying to tell you.

EXCEED your fellow members expectations. If you do, they'll come back over and over. Make good on all your mistakes, and don't make excuses - apologize. Stand behind everything you do.

SWIM upstream. Go the other way. Ignore the conventional wisdom. If everybody else is doing it one way, there's a good chance your club can find its niche by going in exactly the opposite direction.

FUN is what a shag club is all about - have fun, keep shagging, keep smiling, keep hugging, and enjoy yourself!!!
