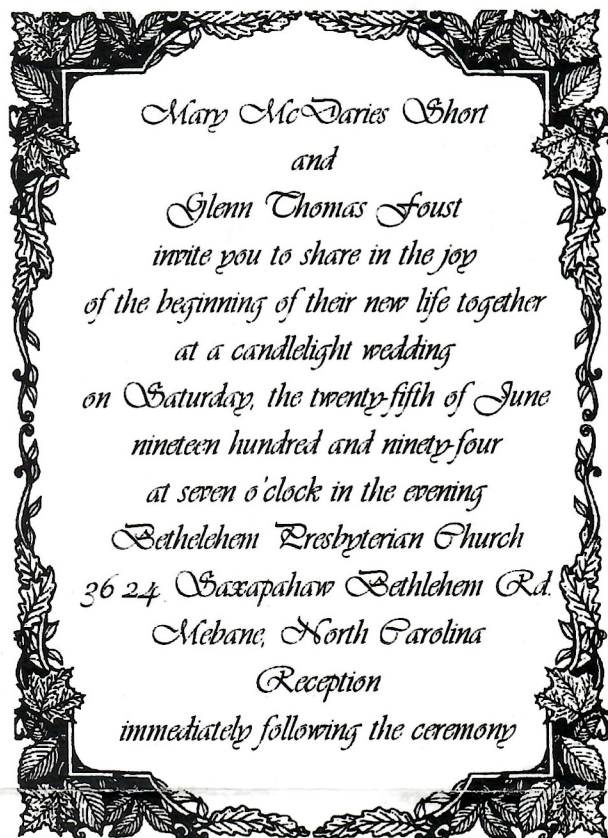

Linda started as a Dj almost five years ago and "*Fat Richard's*" a local hangout for the Burlington shag club. She has played at many clubs in the area including Players Club in Graham and that great group of "frogs" at Eno Shag Club. (I do love their Tee-shirts), *Florence South Carolina Shag Club* hosting the "*Cool Me Out*". Linda, as many may remember, really lit up *Ducks and Ducks II* as a guest during the "*DJ Throwdown*" (held the first weekend in March)
