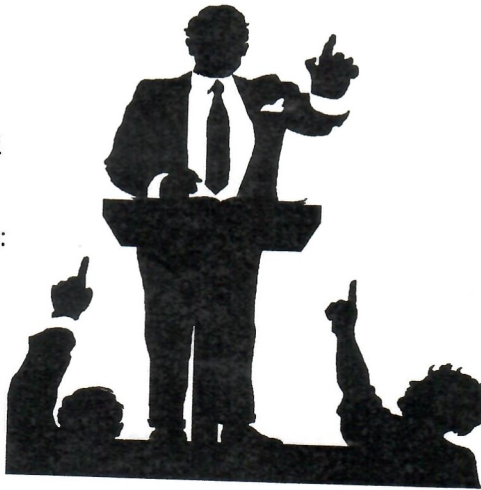
August Meeting Highlights

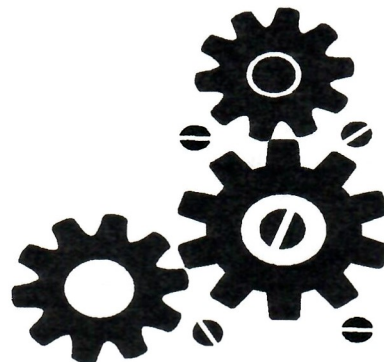

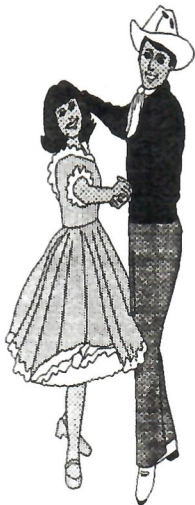
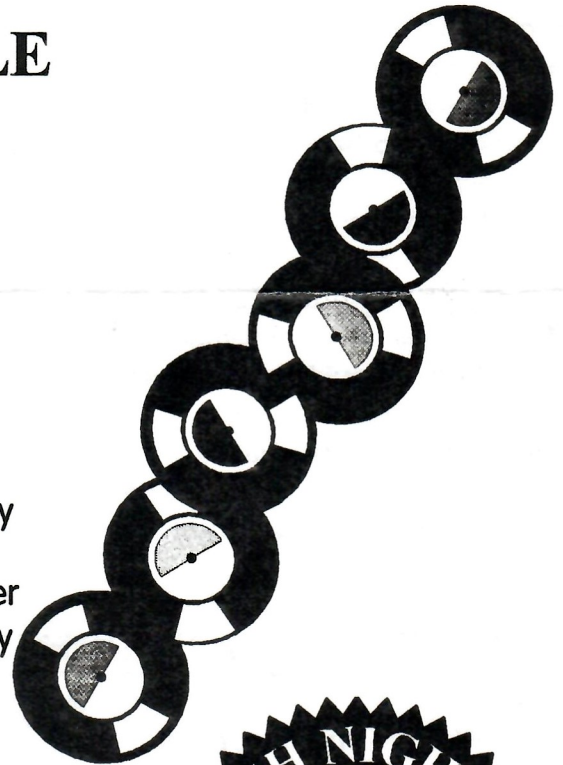
