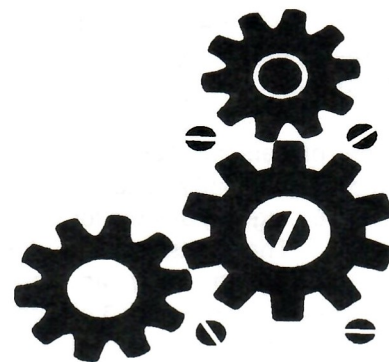

The Shag Rag is published monthly and is distributed to club members, club sponsors and other shag clubs.

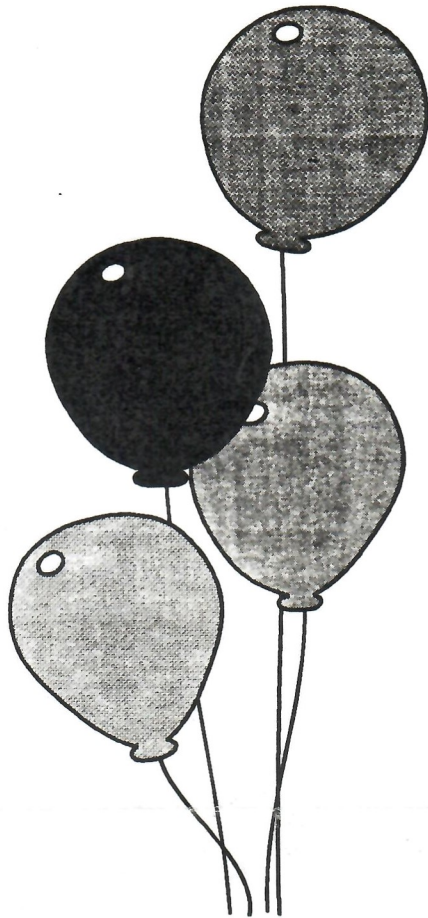
Elections are held every November at the General Business Meeting. Installation of officers takes place at the Christmas party.
