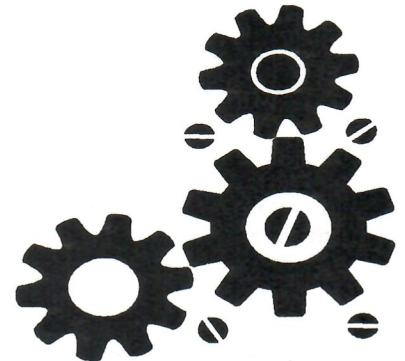

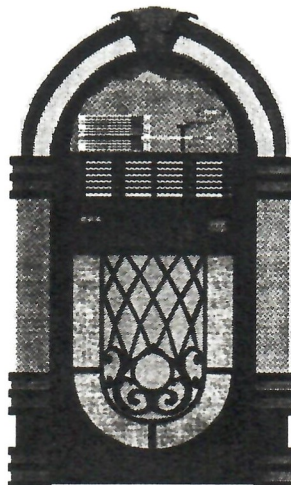

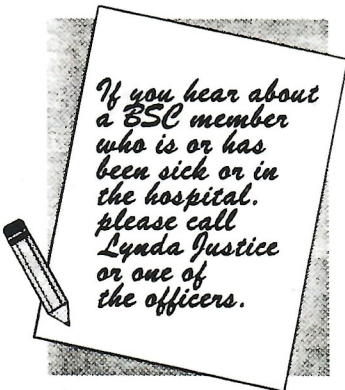

How Much Is Too Much?

So, SOS thinks they can just raise their membership dues without consulting us first, huh? Well, I guess they just don't realize that they have only a marginally valuable product in the first place. If there was a great deal of entertainment value for the dollar in those little SOS cards, maybe they might be justified in expecting us to help with absorbing their "alleged" increased costs. After all, most of us would be willing to help out, if it was necessary to maintain the SOS tradition in the first-class manner that it has been done so far.

But enough is enough! We were already paying over \$2 a month for that little card. **\$2 a month!** I mean, let's be reasonable. How much can two parties a year be worth? With only a half a dozen or so clubs within a one-block radius participating, can it be worth it? After all, for the price of that card we could have dinner for two at Hardwick's. And the free hors d'oeuvres at most of the clubs couldn't compare with that. Or better yet, we could buy over two cases of beer! Now that would be a party! Besides, I hear that they are going to stop the free pours, so we'll soon have to be buying all our own drinks, anyway. And the tram service--it's a nice idea, but whenever I need it, it's not there. Sometimes, I have to wait fifteen minutes for that thing, and when it does come, it's almost full. Then you have to sit all scrunched up against somebody breathing beer in your face. For the price of last year's card you could have called a cab at least a couple of times and had change left over for a tip (if you were the tipping kind, of course. It's a matter of personal preference.) Of course, no matter where you go, the dance floor is crowded. Every time they play my favorite song, there's hardly room to do a simple turn. I end up feeling like I probably ought to just pay a cover charge and go somewhere where it's not so crowded. You can get in almost anywhere for five bucks. For the price of that SOS card you could pay your way in at least five places. And remember, we're talking about for the price of last year's card. The quality of the SOS Carefree Times is incredible, but if the cost of providing us the newsletter is too high, *they* ought to get some

sponsors to pay for it! And that \$300 that they give each new shag club, why not just put a ban on any new clubs. That would take care of that!

If it wasn't enough already, though, now *they* want to raise the price of the card by almost \$0.85! Mind you, I don't mean \$0.85 one time. I mean \$0.85 *every* month! Yes, that's right, we are about to get squeezed for an extra \$10 per year. It works out to about the price of a beer every other month. Can it be worth it? Can *any* party card be worth that much? Why, you can almost join the Moose Lodge for that much, and you can go there every day, if you want to. What's probably actually happening, is that some of the SOS crew is skimming, you know, like politicians do. They've probably started putting themselves and their wives and kids on salary, and ran short of money. Besides, you know none of them ever pay for their own cards, so what do they care how much the cards cost? I say the whole thing is a scam. Prices haven't gone up, and extending the SOS to three times its original length can't cost much more. Nope, I'm convinced that we just need to tell *them* that they'll just have to do whatever they can with \$25 a year, which was already too high, or

In case you haven't already seen through this tongue-in-cheek tirade, please do so now. We shaggers have a well-deserved reputation for being cheapskates and whiners, but at least let's be reasonable in our criticisms of the one organization responsible for some of the best times we ever have. As in any social organization, most of the work is done by the few (often volunteers), and very few of us do anything to contribute to the success of SOS, other than just attending. After all, if the extra ten dollars per year is that important, how can you possibly afford to rent a place to stay, buy meals, pay for gas, go to the Shoe Center, or buy drinks? Rather than complain, why not just skip SOS, stay home and rent a video? Please don't let the prevailing topic of conversation at next SOS be over ten bucks! How boring!

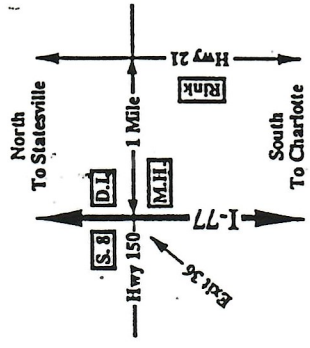
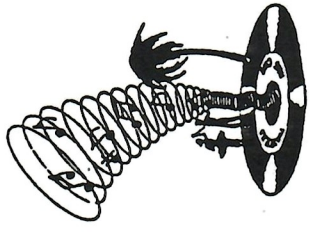
