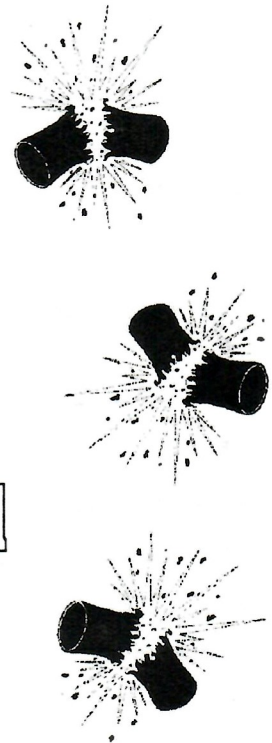

Friday, May 12 was a sad day for those of us who were regular listeners of WRDX 106.5 in Salisbury.

Mr. Dick Harlow and the Dalton Group, also owners of Magic 96 in Charlotte, stated in the Charlotte Observer that the change was made to alternative rock after market research showed 8,000 people in the 18-34 age group showed they wanted an alternative rock station. More to the point, I think they felt WRDX was a threat to Magic 96. Any faithful beach and R&B fan knows there is no comparison, and I will not accept 96 as my radio station.

Eight thousand people is a very small group when you consider WRDX reached people in both Carolinas, Virginia and Tennessee. Not to be forgotten are the twice yearly SOS parties at Ocean Drive and all the free publicity WRDX got when their DJs took part. We fans represent a very large, well established group with money to spend on quality. Too bad Mr. Harlow did not take the time to research us.

In the Observer story, Mr. Harlow stated that this move to alternative rock would fill a gaping hole in radio. Hopefully it will move the gaping hole from his head to his pockets.

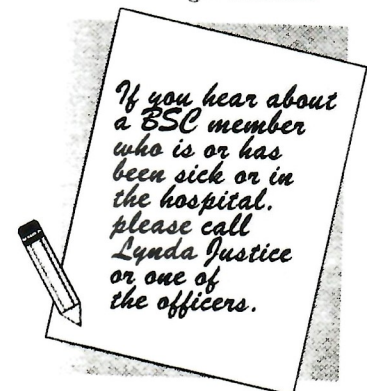

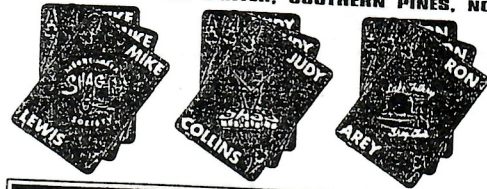

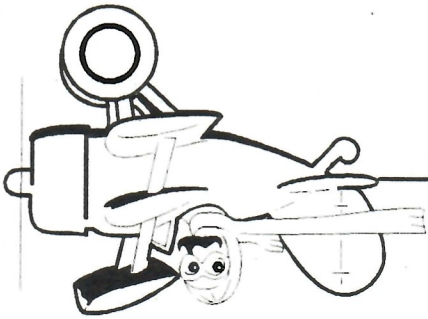
