## Dancing Provides Excellent Aerobic Workout

Shag offers an excellent gentle, low-impact workout. Not as tough on the joints as high impact sports. This is one exercise that almost anyone can do for long periods of time with no risk of injury. There's no need to be in tiptop shape to start out. When followed over a period of time, a vigorous dance program results in the same benefits as any aerobic exercise program: Loss of body fat; increased muscle tone; slowing of the aging process, including retardation of loss of bone mineral contents, improved stamina and endurance, increased energy and resistance to fatigue, and more efficient functioning of the heart and lung. Dancing meets all of today's accepted guidelines for a good aerobic workout. It can raise the heart rate to 60-70 percent of its maximum rate, can be performed for 15 to 30 minutes (can be maintained for an hour without interruption), and can be done at least three times a week. A regular dance program also improves posture, coordination, balance and flexibility.

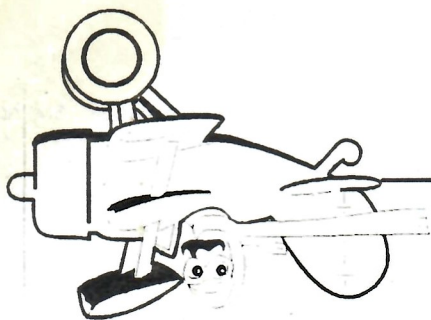

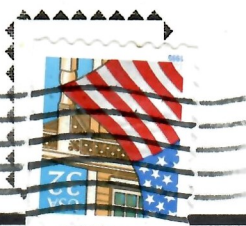
