And better than most I'm often told.

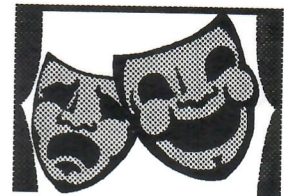

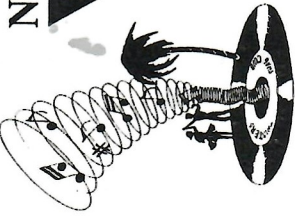

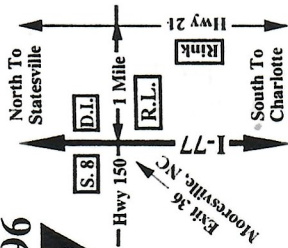
