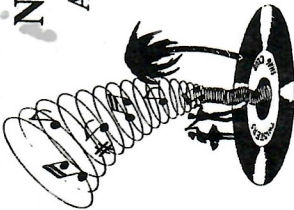

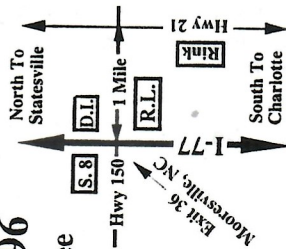

Just over eleven years ago, on August 3rd, 1985, the Burlington Shag Club was organized by Dianne Fogleman and Bob Bullard. Approximately 50 people met at the Best Western lounge and danced to the tunes the DJ's spun. By the end of that year, the membership was in excess of 250.

Diane served the club for two years, then Joan Kimbro followed on a four year lead as president. The club enjoyed house parties to the beach, cookouts, Valentine & Halloween parties, and yes, benefits. From 1988 to 1990, BSC "Shagged For The Heart". These events proved successful and the Burlington Shag Club was on its way to proving that it could raise money for a worthy cause and have a party at the same time!

In 1991, BSC members, Mike and Shirley Valle lost their home in a fire. Under the leadership of Mike Flannigan, then BSC president, the club held a yard sale and bake sale to "help their own". Possibly, this event and the Heart Fund raisers set a precedent for what is now a part of the "soul" of the BSC. A need was seen close to home and the Burlington Shag Club wanted the community to realize that Shaggers love the music and the dance — yes, enjoy a good party: but the bottom line was wanting to give back to the community!

In 1992 when Al Fogleman, BSC member and a member of the Board of Directors for Meals-On-Wheels, approached then president Gail Jordan asking that the club help sponsor a benefit dance for Meals-On-Wheels, she knew the need was there and that the BSC members would rally to help. On October 9th, 1993, the first Meals-On-Wheels Benefit Dance was held at Al's Fine Foods.

The crowds were entertained by a band & DJ's and enjoyed an evening filled with fun, friends and music.

The club planned its second benefit dance for Meals-On-Wheels in October of 1994. However, shortly before the dance, Al's Fine Foods was sold and Al Fogleman (BSC Benefit Chairman) and Bob Maccia (BSC President) had to do some quick re-grouping. Regroup they did! Rescheduling the dance for February 18th at the Ramada Inn in Burlington, the Band of Oz entertained guests in the Grand Ballroom and DJ's spun everyone's favorites in the Carolina-Duke-State rooms. With close to 500 in attendance and some \$12,000.00 was raised for a very worthy organization!

In April of 1995, club president Jonnie Ellington stood proud to represent the Burlington Shag Club and accepted the Volunteers Award from the United Way Agency. Then on October 11th, Jonnie was once again honored on behalf of the club to accept the State of North Carolina - Governor's Volunteer Service Award at Elon College.

In the spring of 1995 Al Fogleman was contacted by the Alamance County Special Olympics to help them with a fUND-RAISER. The club voted to have a benefit golf tournament. Now, BSC has always had fun





golf tournaments and this one was to be no exception to that rule! The warmth and smiles from Special Olympic friends greeted each team of golfers as they approached the holes and the beverage carts kept everyone happy. The BSC raised approximately \$5,000.00 for this important cause ... in just one day!

The Third Annual Meals-On-Wheels Benefit Dance has just been successfully completed. With a weekend attendance of nearly 525 people, the Part Time Party Time band and DJ Hall of Famers Judy Collins, Mike Lewis and Gary Bass kept the crowd dancing and having a great time. Junior Shag Association leader, Wade Adler, arranged a great shag exhibition and the BSC members and guests all chipped in to raise an unprecedented \$15,600.00 at a weekend of partying & shagging!!

Many readers may have seen the beautiful "Shag Afghan" at the beach or advertised in SHAGGER Magazine. It was designed by two BSC members Glenda Harris and Susan Harrell. The BSC produces an excellent monthly newsletter called the "SHAG RAG" for it's members which includes interesting news, officer & committee names and phone numbers, meeting times and dates, business meeting highlights, event flyers from other clubs and much more. Yearly events now include two golf tournaments (1 fun & 1 charity), the "Meals-On-Wheels Benefit Dance, a Summer Blast dance, a Meet The Area Shag Clubs party, Halloween, Christmas and New Year's parties and a monthly Birthday Bash. You can catch up with this busy group of Shaggers at the Masters Tavern inside the Ramada Inn every Friday night.

Preliminary plans have been already set for the Fourth Annual Meals-On-Wheels Benefit dance to be held on February 14 & 15th 1997. The lineup features the Part Time Party Time band and DJ's Murl Augustine, Roy Childress, Joe Pope, Gerry Holland and Jackie McCauley. Mark this one on your 1997 calendar as one weekend party you won't want to miss (and it's a great way to spend Valentines Day!!).

The Burlington Shag Club was one of the first clubs to affiliate with Southern Shaggers Limited as a Sponsor Club and join in our efforts to promote and preserve the music & the dance.
