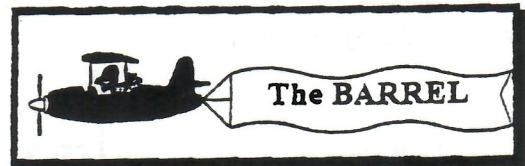

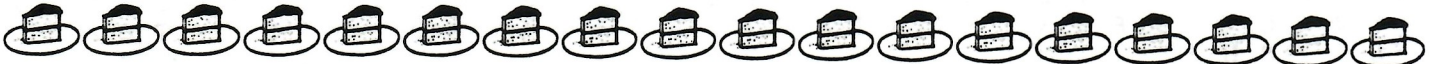

The Association Of Beach and Shag Club Deejays

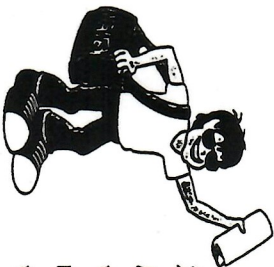
I always enjoy playing music for Burlington Shag Club events - so many nice folks, ready to dance and party! Here are some upcoming events I hope you will all plan to attend:
