No Friday Night Outing

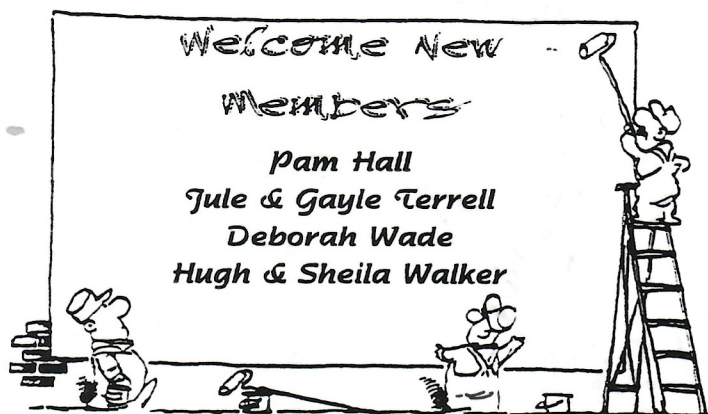
