We shopped for the children and delivered everything a couple of days before Christmas. It was so much fun shopping for these people; it really made Bob and me happy to help these people in such need.

We called the three families on Christmas Day to ask if "Santa" really came to their houses. All of the children were thrilled and their parents thanked us repeatedly and asked if we would convey their thanks to the entire club.

We collected over \$900 and these three families had a visit from "Santa" in thir homes. We bought toys and clothes and purchased gift certificates for food at Food Lion, they did their own food shopping.

This was such a success and we would like to check on these families throughout the year.

This experience has given us a more appreciative outlook on life. There are a lot of people out there who truly need help. If you could have seen the faces of the little 4 year old boy, you would feel this was truly a worthwhile cause.

- 1-1/3 cups skim milk
- 2 small garlic cloves, minced
- 2 tsp. all purpose flour
- 2 Tbsp. Fat free cream cheese
- 1 cup Parmesan cheese
- 1-1/2 tsp. Molly McButter natural butter flavor sprinkles
- 4 cups hot cooked fettuccine

In medium saucepan, over high heat, whisk milk, garlic, flour and cream cheese. Bring to a boil, whisking constantly. Reduce heat and simmer for 2 minutes or until thickened. Add Parmesan cheese, whisk until blended. Remove from heat. Stir in butter sprinkles. Pour sauce over hot noodles. Sprinkle with parsley and pepper if desired.
