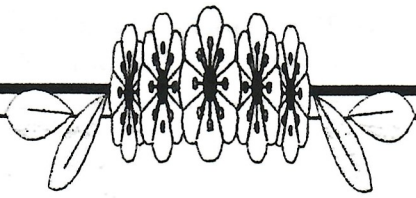

Our annual benefit dance for Alamance County Meals On Wheels is almost here and we need the support of every club member in order to make this event as successful as last year's.

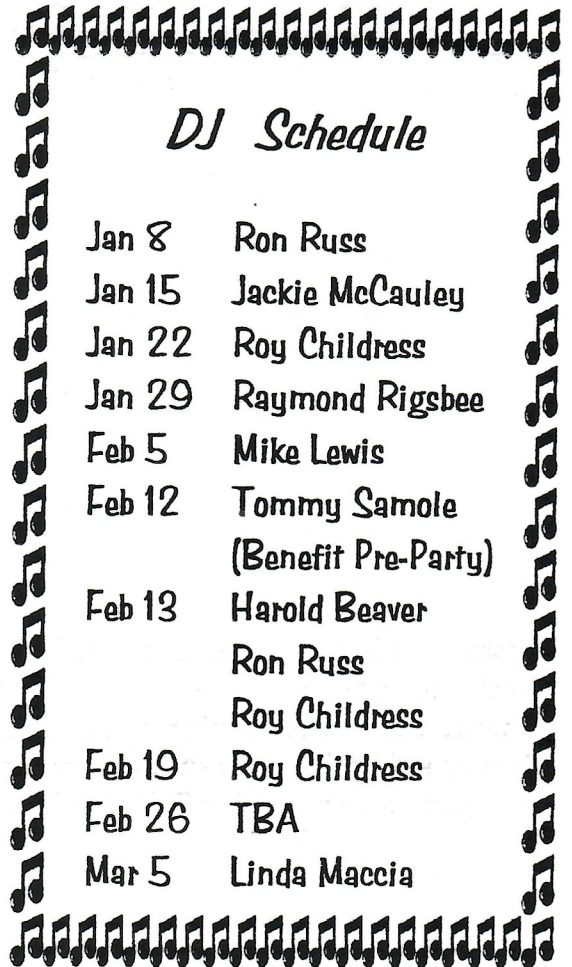

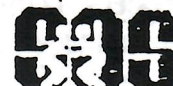

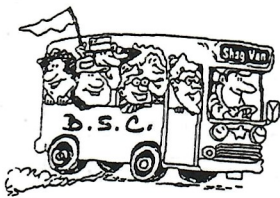
