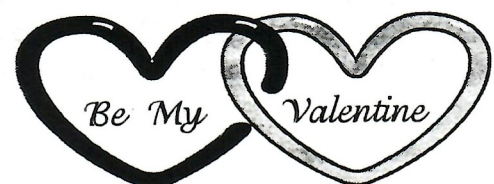

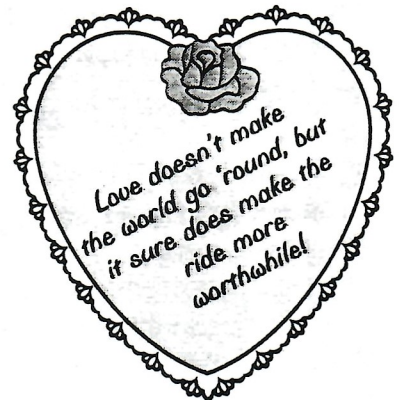

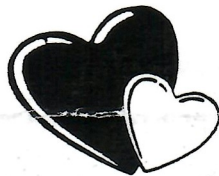

About 11:00 p.m. "The Boogie Brothers" (Ed Timberlake and John Smith) finally crank us up some shag music on the Lido deck. I supplied the baby powder, thank you very much. We shagged until about 1:30 a.m. and had a ball. ⚓

We traveled all night and half the day Saturday to Cozumel. Arrived around 3:30 p.m. and didn't have to be back until midnight. The ship had to dock approximately 3 miles from Cozumel and we took taxis into town. That was fun. No air conditioning, but their horns work! The cruise director told us in advance what to ask the taxi driver: 1) Do you speak English? If they say Si, then you ask; 2) Are you a safe driver? If they say Si, then you ask 3) Did it snow here last night? If they say Si, then you wait for another driver or get in anyway and close your eyes! All we told him was "Touch of Gold" (a jewelry store) and he said Si. We shopped and shopped and shopped. Now we're hungry and thirsty. We walk by this place called "Carlos and Charlie's" that we're not real sure about, but decide to check it out. When we get upstairs we see a crowd from the ship living it up (with their Carlos and Charlie's T-shirts and bandanas on already) on the "drinking only" side of the room. We want to eat first so we're seated on the "eating and drinking" side of the room. We eat (and I'm remembering the whole time who we forgot to get souvenirs for), buy our Carlos & Charlie's T-shirt and go back shopping again. Take a taxi back to the ship, deliver our purchases to the room. Hit the Lido Deck for more of the Caribbean Breeze band. Bunnie (remember her from the shuttle?) is having a good old time. We meet Sandra and Chuck. ⚓

When the band took a break, the cruise director had some of the passengers come up to entertain us. First they picked 6 ladies and had the 6 ladies pick 6 men. Sandra was one of the ladies picked and since Chuck had gone back to their room, she picked Bw. You'll never believe what they made him do - the Macarena! And it's on video. Then they picked more ladies for a hula hoop contest and then for a Madonna lip-sync contest. It was all hilarious. We snacked on the midnight buffet and turned in. ⚓

Sunday was supposed to be a "Funday at Sea". However we woke to the Captain telling us we were in 10+ foot swells, there was a cold front coming in and it was gonna get worse - and it did. Weejun's Shag Party started at 1:00 p.m. and the swells were so bad we wondered if we'd even be able to shag. Murl started us off with a bang as usual. When it came time for the "Boogie Brothers", John Smith was not feeling well so Murl filled in. He and Ed were billed as the "Nookie Brothers". The more we drank the less the swells bothered us. But it was a bit trying having to chase your partner across the floor when the ship dipped. ⚓

Roddy/Weejun's had a free pour from 3-4:00 p.m. We had all kinds of drinks, I remember the Melon Balls. We put baby powder on the floor and the waiters wiped it up, so we put down more. It was so funny to see people trying to stand up, execute mirror steps and end back up in front of their partner (which didn't happen very often). Afterwards Larry and Shirley bought several of us some kind of shooter, (I don't have a clue what it was, but I drank it) and made a flavorful toast. We went down to the "Boiler Room" because Carol had to have a fix (pizza). We raised hell in there for while, had our picture taken, and then went down to the "Dildo Deck" (notice name change) bar for a while. Murl was supposed to play from 11 p.m. to 1 a.m., but it was so cold and windy and the swells were so bad they cancelled it. ⚓

When we got back to our room, Mike and Pat told us we were supposed to have our luggage in the hall by midnight. Reminisced about the night before, Pat's train ride, and found copies of our pictures we had made last night. My mouth was wide open - Bw said it should have been, I didn't close it all night! ⚓

They finally call our tag colors, we say good-bye and debark. Pack the car and we're off. Meet up with Murl and Cindy on the interstate. Write a note with lipstick inviting them to lunch at Daytona. We wanted seafood and we drove a fair piece for it! Followed each other to the good side of Savannah and I wrote this article the rest of the way home! ⚓

I told Bw the truth at the "Rum Swizzle" party. I do love him, I'm so glad we went and we had a ball. Thanks Weejun's. Please send bunches of applications for next year's cruise!!! ⚓

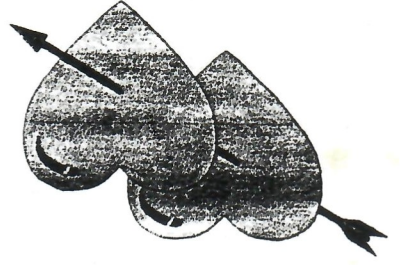
