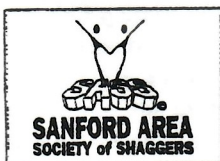
SHAG YOUR SASS OFF is the name of the game. There have been three so far, but never the same. The party is one of the best of its kind. Plenty of good music and food you will find.

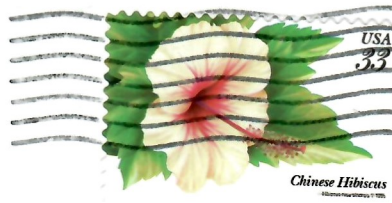
