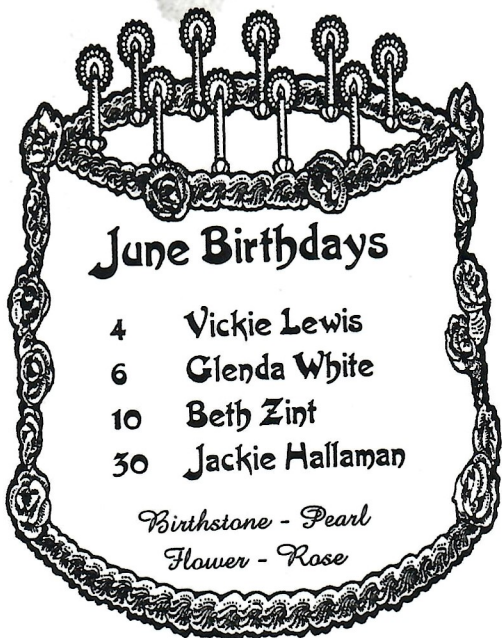

Shag lessons have now been officially cancelled until further notice. If lessons are given again, it probably will not be until Fall.

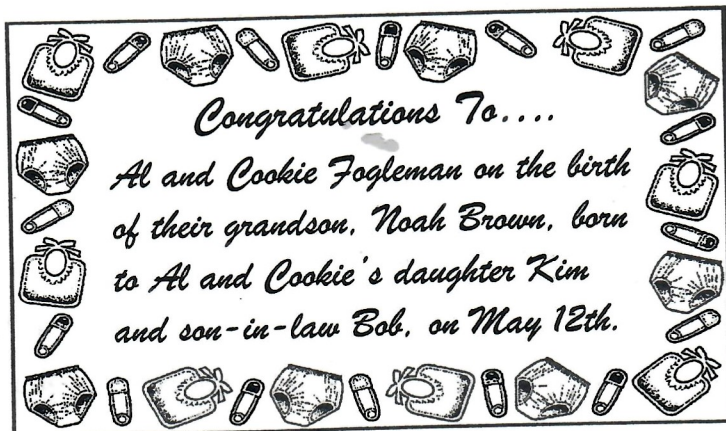
### S.O.S. Raffle Tickets

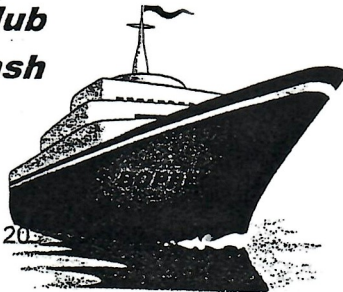


