It seems the shuttle became a very popular ride thanks to the Jello shooters on board, provided by Dotty and Buddy. Our thanks to Steve Stearns of Stearns Ford for providing the shuttle and driver. After dinner, Harold started the music again in the Ballroom and Roy closed out in the Carolina/Duke/State room.

About 9:00 we concentrated on selling our party cooler tickets and 50/50 tickets again. We did not even have to walk the floor to sell 50/50 tickets, because after the DJ's announced how high the amount had gotten, we had people standing in line at the table to buy. With Jesse "making the deals" and counting the tickets off, Pat Jones of Danville taking the money, Larry Strader of Danville splitting the tickets, and me tearing them apart, we worked until we sold every ticket on the roll (this was the second roll of tickets, not just the first!) We finished at 11:15 and had to get a huge dish from the kitchen just to hold all the tickets. At 11:30 we drew for the party cooler first which was won by Dee Hankins from the Danville club and then after we got the crowd to quiet down, we told them we had \$697 to go to the winning ticket holder!!! As anxiety took over the room, the number was drawn - and a very nervous Darrell Moon from the Beckley, WV Shag Club made his way to the front for verification. His hand was shaking so much we had to hold it still to look at the number, but he happily walked away with a pocket full of cash! Harold started back playing and even after the music stopped at 1:00 a.m., there were still shaggers wanting to hang around just a little longer.

Sunday morning started out with hospitality beverages in the Ballroom and the great gospel music provided by Clyde Waller. After having worked so much on Friday and Saturday, those of us from our club and the Danville club had an opportunity to relax a little and enjoy the morning. While Clyde was playing, the "working" members from each club gathered around and in front of Buddy's big record for pictures and a "sing-off" of Amen. Danville had their turn first, under the direction of choir director Lynda Justice, and then we sang with Richard Adams of Danville leading us. It was a fun time and our guests who stayed around on Sunday morning enjoyed it as much as we did.

This was the second "First Place" prize that Kevin and Susan have won in Novice and with one more, they will move up to the Pro Division. We wish you lots of good luck!

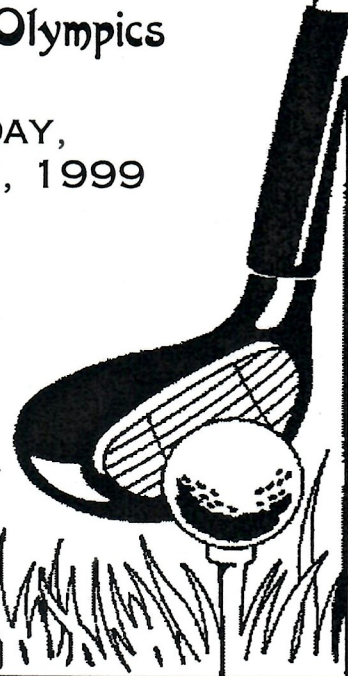

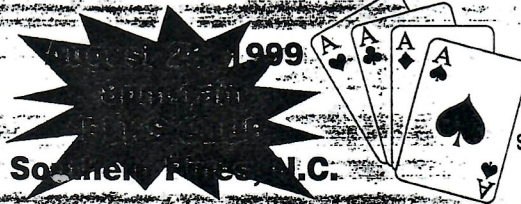
Club Scrapbook

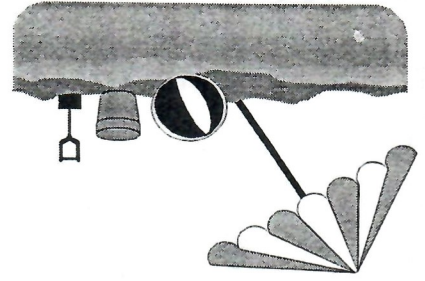
