Dance Classes

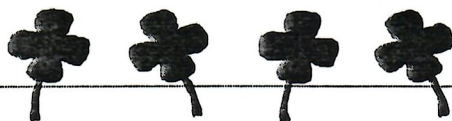

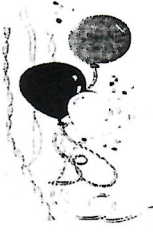
Area Shag Club Party - March 25th
