## Special Olympics Appreciation Award

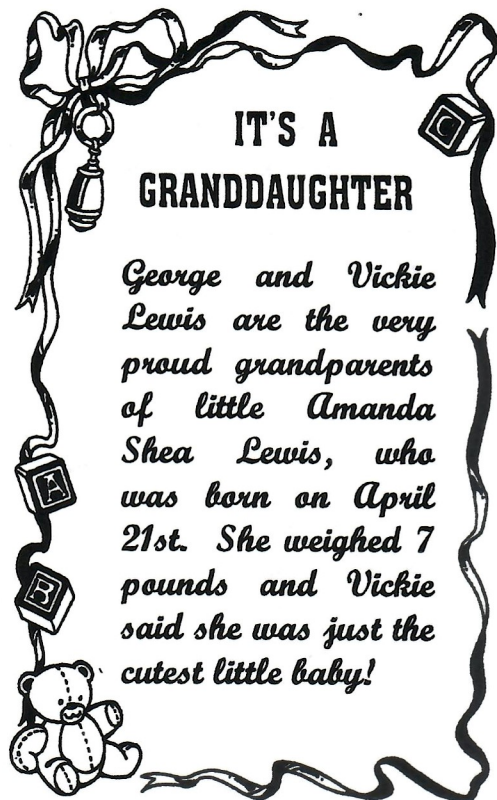
