
Area Shag Club Party - "Fifties Night"

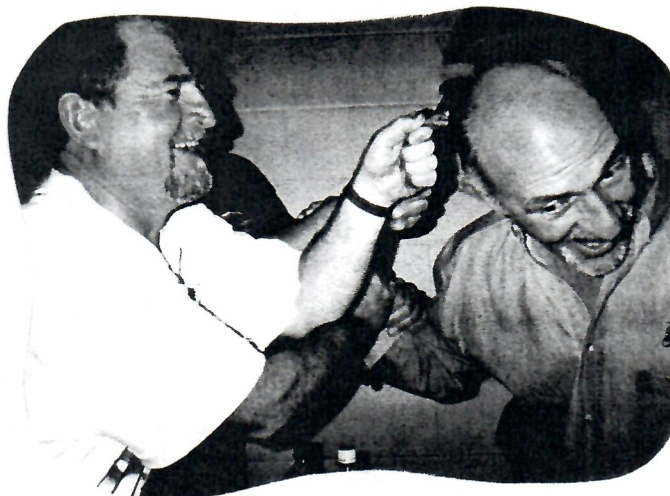
More Fun From The Area Shag Club Party
