After going through this summer with no place to meet, I hope all of you realize the importance of having a "home". I encourage all of you to help us support the club and try to keep our home at Masters. We need to meet once a week and have a DJ to hold this club together. Without a club, we can't perform benefits for Meals On Wheels or Special Olympics. We personally think these benefits are an important part of the club. We are extremely proud to be members of a club that can raise the money we do for these benefits!

Speaking of benefits, we are a non-profit organization. The only money we make is on our memberships. The club has voted and agreed to increase dues to \$15 effective January 1, 2001. We average somewhere around 175 members per year. Multiply that by \$10 and it equals \$1,750. It costs approximately \$150 per month to copy and mail our newsletter. Multiply that by 12 and it equals \$1,800. You do the math. We're already \$50 in the hole and we haven't included any expenses for our "adopted" family or our "free pour" at Fall SOS.

We need to come up with some good ideas to raise money quickly and simply. Be thinking about it. We'll discuss it at our next meeting.

Which brings up another point. The officers do not "run" the club. We simply direct the meeting. We usually have an agenda, but will always ask if there's something else you'd like to discuss. Dotty and I invite you all to attend the meetings. Come tell US your thoughts, ideas, and heaven forbid, your complaints. Help us support this club. Get involved. Volunteer. We're looking forward to another great year with the BURLINGTON SHAG CLUB.

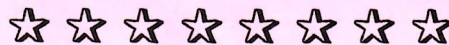

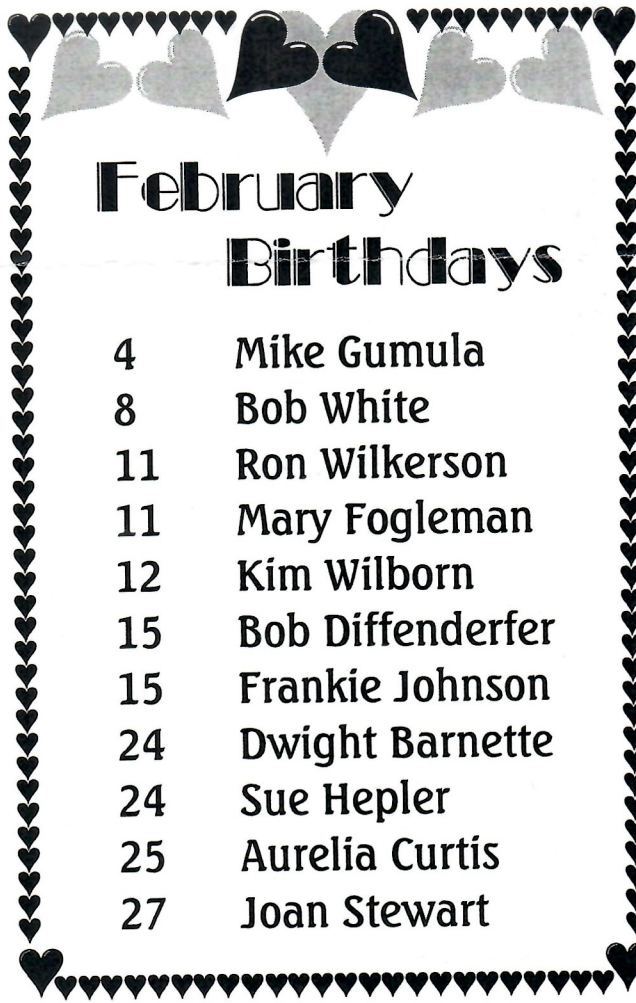
