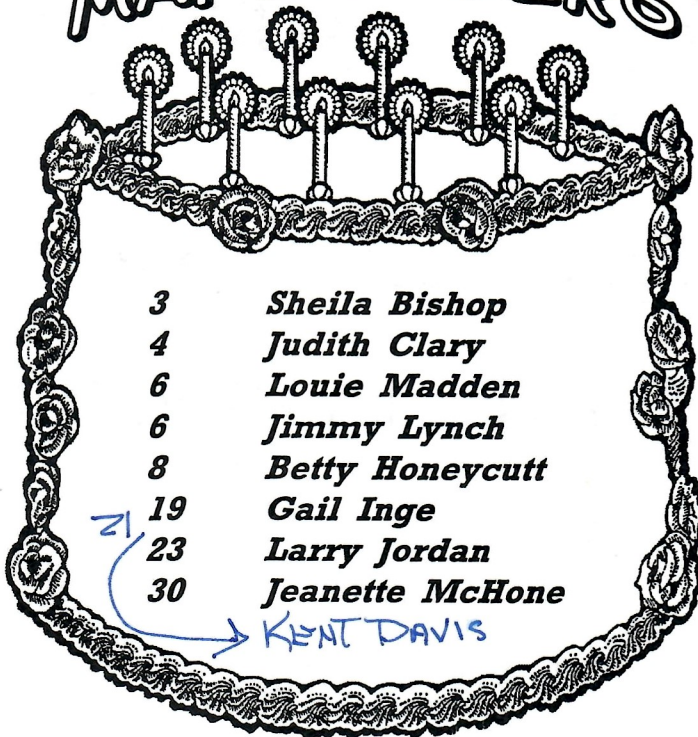
Another Great IRS Party

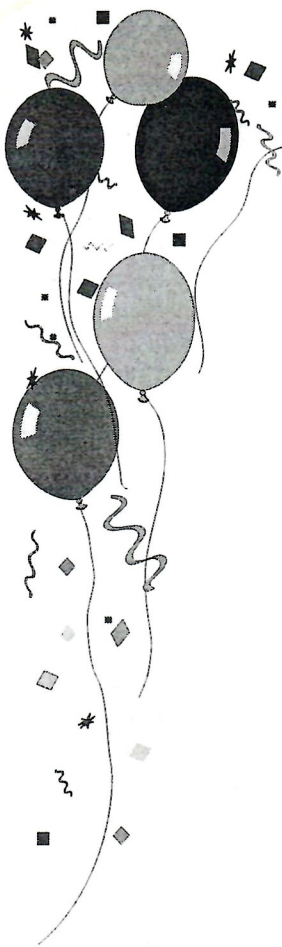

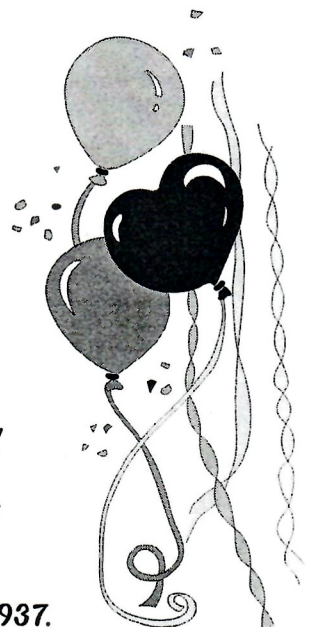

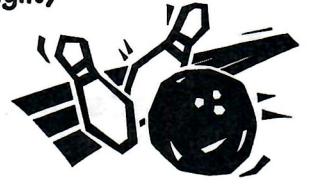
