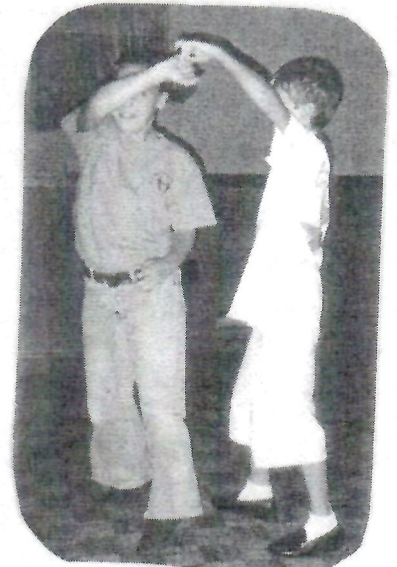
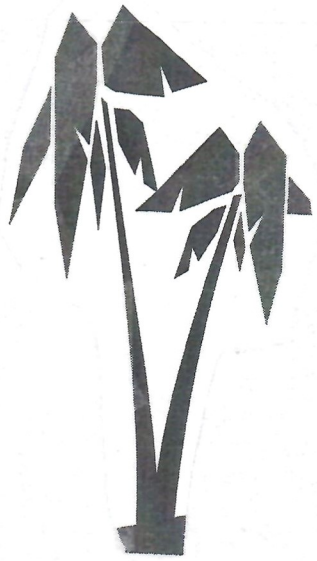


## Register Early !!

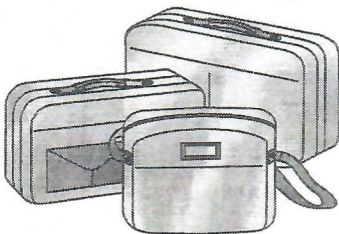
