Proposed Amendment to By-Laws

submitted by Dotty Whaley

Under VIII. Committees - Add

6. Hall Of Fame Committee

- a) Chairperson is appointed by the club President.
- b) Committee shall consist of all the Hall of Fame Members, the committee Chairperson, and the present elected officers.
- c) To be selected, individuals must have distinguished themselves in the Shag Community for a minimum of three (3) years in ONE OR MORE of the following categories:
 - 1. Distinguished service as an officer or committee chairperson of the club.
 - 2. Regular attendance and participation in area shag lounges.
 - 3. Regular attendance and participation in our club, ACSC, and SOS events.
 - 4. Distinguished service as a teacher, judge, or competitor in local, area, or national shag competitions.
- d) All nominations will be submitted by a current Hall of Fame member (on the club's nomination form) directly to the chairperson.
- e) All nominations must be received by November 1st.
- f) Voting shall be by secret ballot by the club's membership at the November meeting. No proxy votes or absentee ballots.
- g) No more than two persons shall be inducted in the Hall of Fame in any given year.
- h) New inductees shall be announced at the club's Christmas Party.
- i) New inductees shall be made life-time members of the club.
- j) Inductees shall be recognized by their names being added to the club's Hall of Fame plaque.
- k) New inductees shall be honored by a spotlight dance with the person of their choice and then a spotlight break dance by any and all in attendance.
- l) After the spotlight break dance for the new inductees, there will be a special spotlight dance for all members of the Hall of Fame present.

Minutes of July Business Meeting

8. Steppin' Out Shaggin' Shag Club of Rockingham County benefit golf tournament is scheduled for Saturday, August 3rd. Golfing members were encouraged to play if could.
9. Member news - it was announced that Mary Ann Lynch had surgery recently.
10. Brenda Smith brought up the idea of having a booth for Fun Monday. She had good ideas of things to sell. Members voted to have a booth and hold the amount of money to spend at about \$700. Brenda will be the chairman for the Fun Monday booth and will work with members on getting items to sell.
