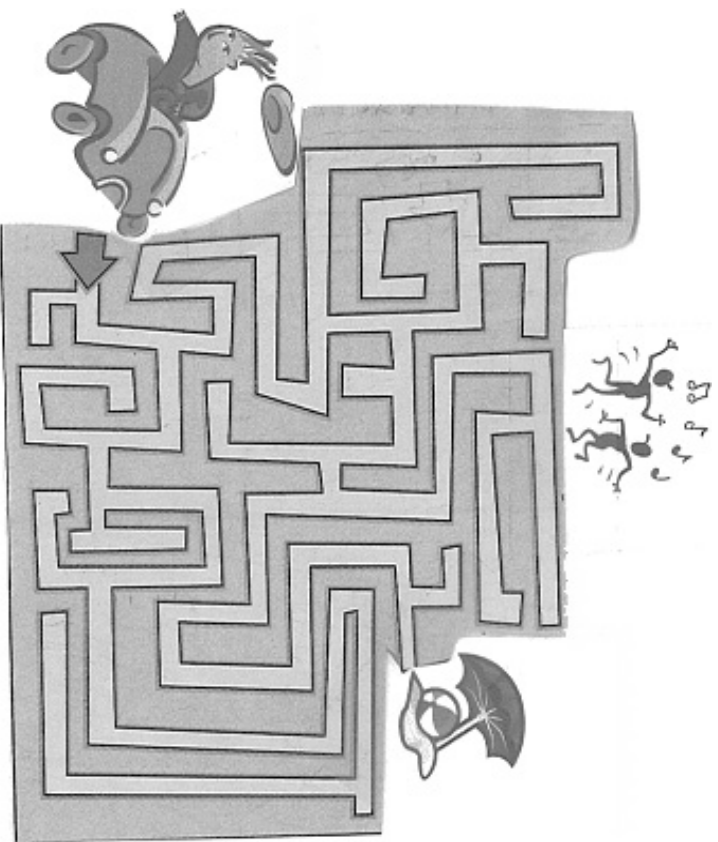

4. Christmas Float - Judy Lindley was not at the meeting to report on this. Ronnie asked if anyone else wanted to take on the responsibility of checking out details. If not, he would try to call Judy again.
5. Membership report - Kent said his committee had called some who had not renewed and would call others. He noted that Tammy Allen has cancer and asked if we could take up donation for her membership dues. It was suggested that we take up donation, take out amount for her dues, and give balance to Tammy. This was agreed among members present. There will be \$110 to go to Tammy and Kent will see that she gets it.
6. Ronnie told us that the ACSC had established a scholarship at the University of South Carolina in the name of Dr. Phil Sawyer. This will be a "dance/shag scholarship" and will go to a deserving student. Author Bo Bryan has donated a copy of his book "Shag" to every shag club for members to sign. When through, each club's book will be put on Ebay and amount raised (less \$30 cost of book) will go to the scholarship fund. Ronnie reminded everyone of Dr. Phil's motto: "A cold beer on a warm night with a hot date and no plans for tomorrow". If you have not signed the book our club has, please see Ronnie or Mary.

- Summer Workshop - The La Quinta hotel has been added to our flyer. Mary asked that members volunteer to work on committees. If you are interested to work, please contact the following chairmen: Carol Oliver - decorations; Kent Bradsher and Butch Dowd - door duty; Rick & Donna Campbell - midnight snacks; Denise Upchurch - photography; Brenda Smith - pool party; Chuck Upchurch - set up and clean up; Rick & Debbie Wolfe - social; and Steve McHone - 50/50 and raffle. Your help will be needed to make this a successful weekend event. Also, our own members need to go ahead and send their money in for registration.
 - Steppin' Out Shag Club in Eden hosted their "Area" party last Saturday night and everyone seemed to have a good time. Burlington had 22 on a bus to the party. Jesse Justice won the 50/50 drawing - \$216.
 - Denise reminded members if they want to ride a party bus to some of these events, don't wait until the last minute to let her know. Call her ahead of time so she can plan for the amount. Also Mike Wilson has offered his RV for trips. Ronnie thanked Denise and Chuck for their work.
 - SOS Parade Float - Brenda said the committee has had a meeting to start plans. She said there is room for anyone who wants to participate. It is \$20 to ride the float, which helps the funding. We could use more sponsors (\$100 or more will get a t-shirt and sponsor sign on the float). This would be a tax deductible contribution. Information will be on the website.
 - SOS weekends at Master's Lounge. Ronnie asked if enough members would be at the lounge to constitute paying a DJ for the first weekend. A vote was taken and passed that we will NOT have a DJ for the first or second weekend during SOS.
 - Danville's IRS Party is April 1st. Make plans to attend and if you are interested in a bus, please contact Denise early.
 - Meals On Wheels Benefit Report - Anne Baker, Director for Meals On Wheels, said a gross of \$21,924 was raised. Ticket sales were \$6,451; exhibition dancers \$729, raffle \$1,465; 50/50 \$489, pictures \$45, and sponsors \$12,745. After expenses, the net total was \$15,877. Al Fogleman, Benefit Chairman, was asked to address the meeting. He said that other benefits in the area had not done as well as in year's past either, but the club should be proud of what it has done. He said some members had commented about holding a benefit for other organizations, but Al said that no matter what group it is, people have to participate. Some have commented that the ticket price is too high (\$25), to that Al asked if some people thought \$25 a year was too much to donate to such a worthy organization. The date may have been a factor since it was the weekend after Valentine's Day. Ronnie asked that members think about this and rededicate themselves to this fundraiser. Pam McHone suggested perhaps we should do something different, maybe in the spring or summer. Brenda suggested that we change the theme and get away from red, pink, and white.

Chuck asked if not having the silent auction made a difference and it was agreed that was probably a factor in lower attendance and monies. Charlie Gregory, a member who drives from Goldsboro often, complimented the club for their accomplishments. He said he admires the work we do and brags about it to others. Charlie suggested that we sponsor the Meals On Wheels benefit again next year. A motion was made, seconded, and vote passed. Anne thanked the club for their support and said she appreciate what we do and really enjoys working with us.

15. By-Laws - Sheila passed out drafts of the proposed by-law changes. Please read and make suggestions. If you did not get a copy, see Sheila. This will be discussed later.
16. The 50/50 drawing was won by Baxter Sellars - \$60.
17. Next business meeting will be April 14 - one week earlier because of SOS.
18. With no other business to discuss, Ronnie closed the meeting at 9:05 p.m.

ACSC/SOS Winter Workshop in Columbia Feb. 24th and 25th, 2006

A summary of items that were discussed at this meeting are as follows:

- The ICONS were announced, Dott Smith, Islander Shag Club; Rosemary Parten; Sanford Area Shag Club; Norman Mills, Hickory Shag Club; Hollis Britt, Carolina Shag Club; Sonny Brown, Lake Norman Shag Club; and Fred Anders, Twin Rivers. Congratulations to all.
- A reminder about getting registrations to Don David for the SOS Parade.
- It was announced that a new "Phil Sawyer Scholarship" was being established at the University of South Carolina in honor of Phil Sawyer. Phil is largely responsible for the ACSC and SOS as we know it today. Phil was in on the "ground floor". As a past Chairman of the ACSC, and past President of SOS, Phil's contributions to the shag world are enormous. The scholarship will be given to someone who has an interest in the school of dance, and will be teaching shag in K – 12. \$25,000 was initially put into a fund, although the goal is to end up with at least \$100,000 in an "endowment" type of account so that the interest will pay the scholarship each year. Additional contributions can be made by individuals, groups, clubs, etc. and are fully tax deductible. A lot of clubs are thinking of ways to raise money to add to this fund in an attempt to reach \$100,000. Congratulations Phil! Each club was given a book "The Shag" by the Author Bo Bryan. Each club should as many of their members to sign it as possible and then put it on EBAY to auction it off. The money will go to the Phil Sawyer Scholarship

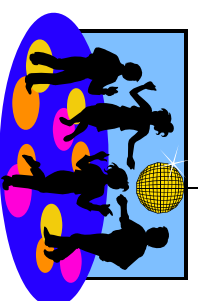

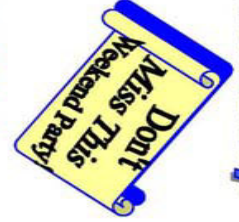
